Proposed 3-Tier Structure to SH

- Tier 1 Virtual Services Only
 - Slightly lower reimbursement rate
 - Stakeholder feedback suggested a preference for 1 rate for all and not by SIS level
- Tier 2 Current Service Delivery Model
 - Services provided as they were pre-pandemic
 - Reimbursement rate remains as is
- Tier 3 Individual, 1:1 SH
 - Reimbursement rate would be higher
 - Lower weekly maximum for number of hours
 - Stakeholder feedback suggested a preference for 1 rate for all and not by SIS level

Proposed 3-Tier SH Limits

- Must remain budget neutral
- Budget set by General Assembly for FY 20-21 accounted for utilization reductions due to COVID-19
- No flexibility in the current budget for rate increases
- These limits are also combined with SCC, PreVoc, and Supported Employment

Proposed 3-Tier SH Limits cont.

- Tier 1 no maximum other than yearly unit cap
- Tier 2 maintains current average weekly/monthly limits - based on yearly unit cap
- Tier 3 maximum of 5 hours/20 units a week

- Stakeholder feedback expressed the need for Tier 1 & 2 to be able to be combined within same week
- Limit would need to be set for Tier 1 & Tier 3 provided in the same week

- With the weekly limits needing to be quite low, do you feel Tier 3, 1:1 SH, is worth pursuing?
- Do you feel SH needs to have a long-term telehealth option?

Proposed 3-Tier Structure to SCC

- Tier 1 Virtual SCC services only
 - Slightly lower reimbursement rate
 - Stakeholder feedback suggested a preference for 1 rate for all and not by SIS level
- Tier 2 Current practice and rate
- Services provided as they were pre-pandemic
 - Reimbursement rate remains as is
- Tier 3 1:1 in-person SCC
 - Reimbursement rate would be higher
 - Lower weekly maximum for number of hours
 - Stakeholder feedback suggested a preference for 1 rate for all and not by SIS level

Proposed Limits for SCC

- Tier 1 no maximum other than yearly unit cap
- Tier 2 maintains current average weekly/monthly limits - based on yearly unit cap
- Tier 3 maximum of 2 hours/8 units a week

- Stakeholder feedback expressed the need for Tier 1
 & 2 to be able to be combined within same week
- Limit would need to be set for Tier 1 & Tier 3 provided in the same week

Feedback on 3-Tier SCC

- What questions or concerns do stakeholders have about this proposed approach?
- With the weekly limits needing to be quite low, do you feel Tier 3, 1:1 SCC, is worth pursuing?
- Do you feel SCC needs to have the option to be provided via telehealth, long-term?
- What obstacles do you see for members and providers trying to implement this 3-tier approach?

Monthly Spending Limit

- Alternative idea using a monthly dollar amount limit instead of a unit limit
- Only feasible if the Department moves forward with the 3-tier structure to both SH and SCC
- All Day Habilitation services, SH and SCC, would be combined under one monthly dollar limit by SIS level

For both SH and SCC combined

Which Option Would Work Best?

- Day Habilitation services options long-term:
 - Move forward with the 3-tier structure to Day Habilitation, including a single rate for Tier 1 (virtual services), using the current rate for Tier 2 (current Day Hab practice broken out by SIS level), and a single rate for Tier 3 (1:1 service).
 - 3 tier structure to Day Hab (virtual, current practice, and 1:1), however instead of limiting both SH and SCC with a unit limit, Day Hab services would have a monthly dollar cap limit.
