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



What is a Certified Professional Midwife?

- Practices in Free Standing Birth Centers (FSBCs) or Home Births
- Scope of Practice:
 - >Outlined in DORA
 - > Perinatal support (prenatal, labor and delivery, postpartum) period)
 - >Care, education, counseling and support
 - > Physical exams, administer medications, order and interpret lab/diagnostic tests

> Do not prescribe medications


• Also referred to as Direct Entry Midwife (DEM)



National CPM Medicaid Coverage

As of April 2023,

19 states reimburse both **CNMs and CPMs**





Only Certified Nurse-Midwives Reimbursed (32 states)



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
Both Certified Nurse-Midwives and Midwives Reimbursed (19 states)






