



Well Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life

Measure Description

The percentage of enrolled patients who turned 15 months old during the measurement year and who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during their first 15 months of life:

- Six or more well-child visits.

Evaluation Period

Calendar Year

Numerator

Seven separate numerators are calculated, corresponding to the number of patients who received 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or more complete well-child visits, on different dates of service, with a PCP during their first 15 months of life. The well-child visit must occur with a PCP, but the practitioner does not have to be assigned to the patient.
