# 2. Department Updates

Presentation: ACC Discussion - Matt Sundeen

Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) has been completing the ACC in phases. The ACC was developed from a need to support members.

ACC Phase 2: will be completed in 2025. The ACC focuses on regionality, regional solutions. Divide the state into multiple regions, promoting physical and behavioral health (BH). We contract with PCMPs and are responsible for incorporating BH component. RAEs are responsible on both sides of regular care and BH.

ACC Phase 3: Work on phase 3 began a year ago. Community engagement is ongoing. A draft was released in Nov. 2023. Final RFP will be done in 2024 with awards is Sept. 2024.

**Stakeholder engagement:** Doing plenty of work on stakeholder engagement. Most members are getting the support they need. This work supports members and providers. The RAEs will have advisory committees as we look forward.

Challenges: Administrative and in contracting, there are some inconsistencies.

- Alignment with knowledge and gaps for BH services.
- RAE models versus CO Plan
- Our method: Feel it meets the needs of our members and providers
- Full managed arrangement does not work with our members
- RAE model is partial managed model, hybrid

### **Quality Care Development:**

- High level Strategic incentives
- Standardized BH for youth
- Measures: Choose from objectives from CMS measures to reduce the admin burden on those providers
