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Incorrect Eligibility Determinations

FY 2021-22 Success

Incorrect Eligibility Determinations	Target	Actual
Statewide (Counties only)	Federal = 3%	1.7%
County Size	MAP Target	Actual
Small	≤5.5%	2.2%
Medium	≤6.6%	1.4%
Large	≤7.3%	1.4%



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Incorrect Eligibility Determinations

FY 2022-23 Targets: Proposed

No change!

These targets are identical to FY 2021-22 targets.

County Size	FY22-23 Target Tier 1	FY22-23 Target Tier 2
Small	≤5.5%	≤14.6%
Medium	≤6.6%	≤13.2%
Large	≤7.3%	N/A



Errors That Did Not Impact Eligibility

FY 2021-22 (before Small Size Review Exemptions applied)

Errors That Did Not Impact Eligibility	Target	Actual
Statewide (Counties only)	Federal = 3%	19.8%
County Size	MAP Target	Actual
Small	≤23.2%	22.3%
Medium	≤16.9%	15.6%
Large	≤17.9%	16.4%

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Read-Only Users

The draft guidance sets a requirement that read-only users also have LMS accounts. Proposed changes include:

- Read-only users must have completed the CBMS Read-Only Training Plan, but once complete, will not be required to complete other trainings or maintain an LMS account.
- The county must keep documentation that the read-only user has completed the appropriate read-only training.
