

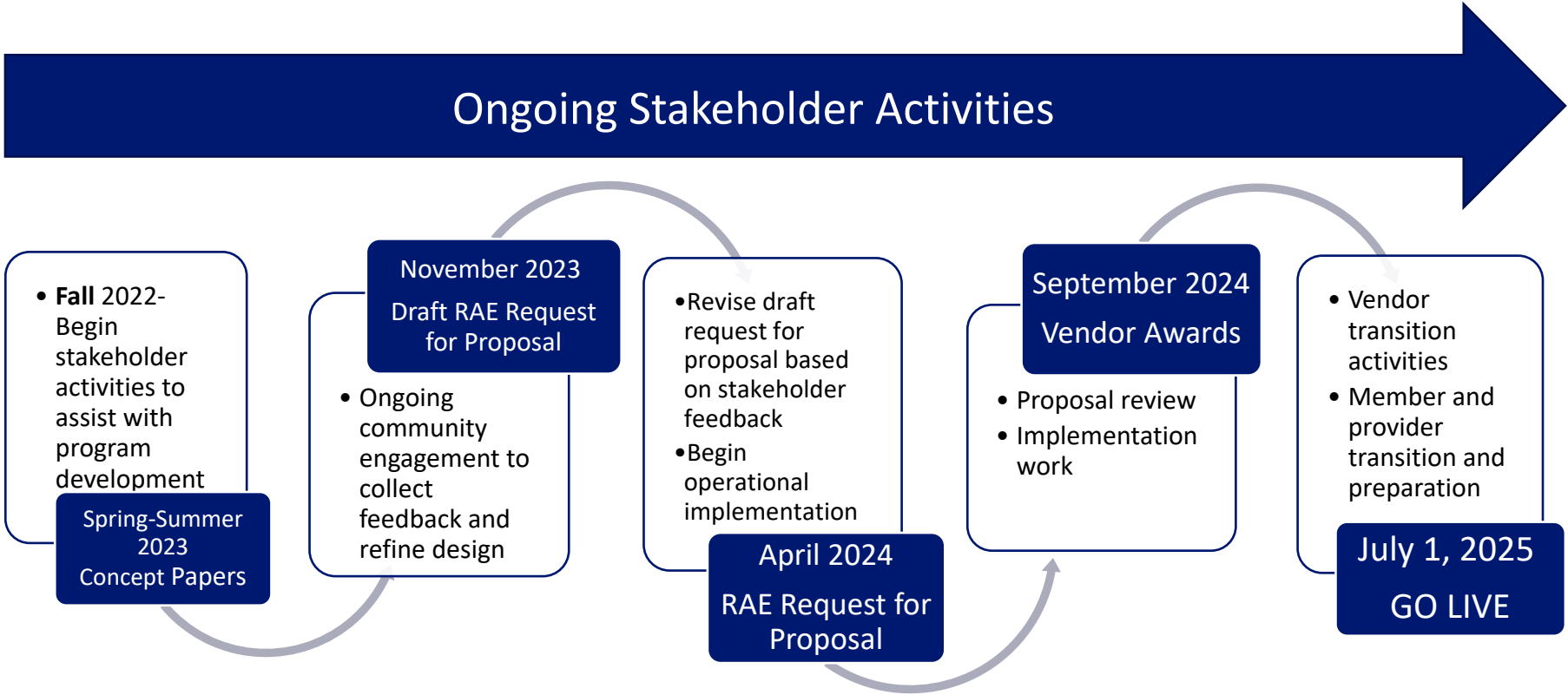

Project Background

- JSI Research & Training Institute, Inc. (JSI) is under contract with HCPF to conduct a stakeholder-informed process improvement initiative (February 2023 - January 2024)
