2	Per Member Per Month	All contracted PCMP providers serving Health First Colorado newly-attributed and/or members not seen by a Provider at PCMP practice for over 24 months are eligible for a PMPM payment.	100%	A primary care provider contracted with the RAE to participate in the Accountable Care Collaborative as a Network Provider.	135	After the first quarter, CCHA has elected to pay a PMPM of \$1 for members whom are newly attributed and/or have not been seen by a Provider at a Practice, as evidenced by a lack of claims.
3	Per Member Per Month	All contracted Accountable Care Network Providers are serving Health First Colorado members are eligible to receive a PMPM payment.	16.3%	Accountable Care Network Providers provide integrated care coordination and population health management to Health First Colorado members.	22	The Accountable Care Network PMPM ranges from \$3.00-\$5.50 and is based on population and quality of services provided.
