
Investment in Primary Care

The investment: Approximately \$50 million per year

The condition: Must be paid through a value-based

payment structure

APM 1 is how HCPF allocates that investment.




^{*}The per year investment is subject to caseloads and Joint Budget Committee appropriated reimbursement rates.


Performance-Based Investments in Primary Care

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


Primary care medical providers have built processes for quality reporting and moving toward outcomes-based measures

Program Year 2022 Performance




- About 87% of PCMPs met the point threshold
- 71 PCMPs were automatically awarded 100 points for being a recognized patient-centered medical home


Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months - Administrative




Well-Child Visits for Ages 15-30 Months -Administrative




Childhood Immunization Status (Combo 10) - eCQM




Childhood Immunization Status (Combo 10) -Administrative





Controlling High Blood Pressure - eCQM




Screening for Depression - eCQM




Diabetes: Hemoglobin A1c Poor Control - eCQM


