# Changes to Voting Membership

- ➤ In an effort to better align with PIAC, created Voting Member Terms: 4-year terms with no more than 2 consecutive terms allowed. (PIAC year: October 1-September 30)
- ➤ On a quarterly basis, P&CE to solicit volunteers to apply for open voting member seats. P&CE chair (or co-chairs), current voting members and HCPF liaison to review applications and appoint new voting members. (Timing may dictate that a new voting member complete the year term of the prior voting member in order to officially start their term Oct. 1.)
