



Dear Provider,

Effective January 7, 2026, new X12 file naming standards were introduced by the Department of Health Care Policy & Financing. Trading partners such as billing agents or clearinghouses who submit batch X12 transactions on behalf of a provider should now be in compliance with the new file naming standards.

Records indicate that you are associated with a trading partner who has submitted non-compliant X12 files as of January 20, 2026. **Please contact your trading partner to confirm they are using the new X12 file naming standards.**

Trading Partners should review the [X12 File Naming Standards Quick Guide web page](#) to ensure they have implemented the new file naming structure and are aware of new file names for response and acknowledgement files, such as the Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA), are now being used.

Please ensure your vendor has adjusted their system to retrieve reports before they expire. A copy of the Remittance Advice (RA) may be obtained on the [Provider Web Portal](#) if unable to obtain a copy from the vendor.
