Behavioral Health Secure Transportation

Behavioral Health Secure Transportation (BHST) is a benefit for all Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) members who are experiencing a **behavioral health crisis** and require **urgent transportation** for behavioral health stabilization and treatment.

- Transportation from the site of the behavioral crisis to the closest, most appropriate facility.
- A behavioral health crisis <u>must</u> be established by 5 types of professionals
 - Skilled professional
 - Intervening Professional
 - Independent professional person
 - Certified peace officer
 - An Emergency Medical Services (EMS)



BHST Continued

- Transportation between the following types of facilities
 - o An emergency medical services facility, including but not limited to: hospitals, hospital units, freestanding emergency departments, psychiatric hospitals, community clinics, behavioral health entities, substance abuse treatment facilities, crisis stabilization units, or acute treatment units.
- BHST providers must submit the BHST 250+ Mileage Verification Form, (Provider Forms web page) The form must be filled out by the <u>Behavioral Health provider</u> who requested the BHST trip.
