- RE: SSN Modification and a New Way to Log In to the BUS

# What is changing?

On Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> 2016, client Social Security Numbers (SSNs) in the BUS will be modified to a "trailing four" and there will be a new way to log in to the BUS.

### **SSN Modification**

There are many pages in the BUS where a client's SSN is displayed in full. Full SSNs appear within client information pages, on page headings and as part of case management reports. In an effort to protect the confidentiality of client data, on Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> 2016, all full SSNs in the BUS (with one exception) will be reduced to a trailing four. Reducing a full SSN to a trailing four will see the first five numbers of the SSN masked as **★** but the last four numbers will still be displayed.

One full copy of the client SSN will remain in the BUS on the Client Demographic page (see below).

#### New Way to Log In to the BUS

On Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> 2016, there will be a new way to log in to the BUS. To access the BUS on October 24th, you will first click on the link below

Next, you will select BUS Access (see below). Do not select BUS Test Access or BUS Training Access, as these options will not take you into the BUS and are only used for testing and training purposes.

After clicking on BUS Access, you will be taken to the next BUS log in page (see below). Here you will enter your existing BUS user name and password. It is important to enter your BUS user name and password and not your Web Portal username and password. On this page, you are also required to enter a CAPTCHA (Completely Automated Public Turing Test To Tell Computers and Humans Apart) script. The script below would be entered as EUgRdU. Don't forget to click the User Agreement before selecting the Login! button.
