Policy Updates

- There are no upcoming Policy changes to note at this time.
- Colorado received approval of <u>1115 Waiver Amendments</u> that includes multiple components (Continuous Eligibility, Re-entry Services, SMI/SED expanded coverage for stays in IMDs, and coverage for Health Related Social Needs [HRSN]).
- Additionally, <u>ACC Phase 3</u> begins July 1, 2025
 - Once the RAE contracts are signed, RAEs will communicate with providers to begin contracting updates.


