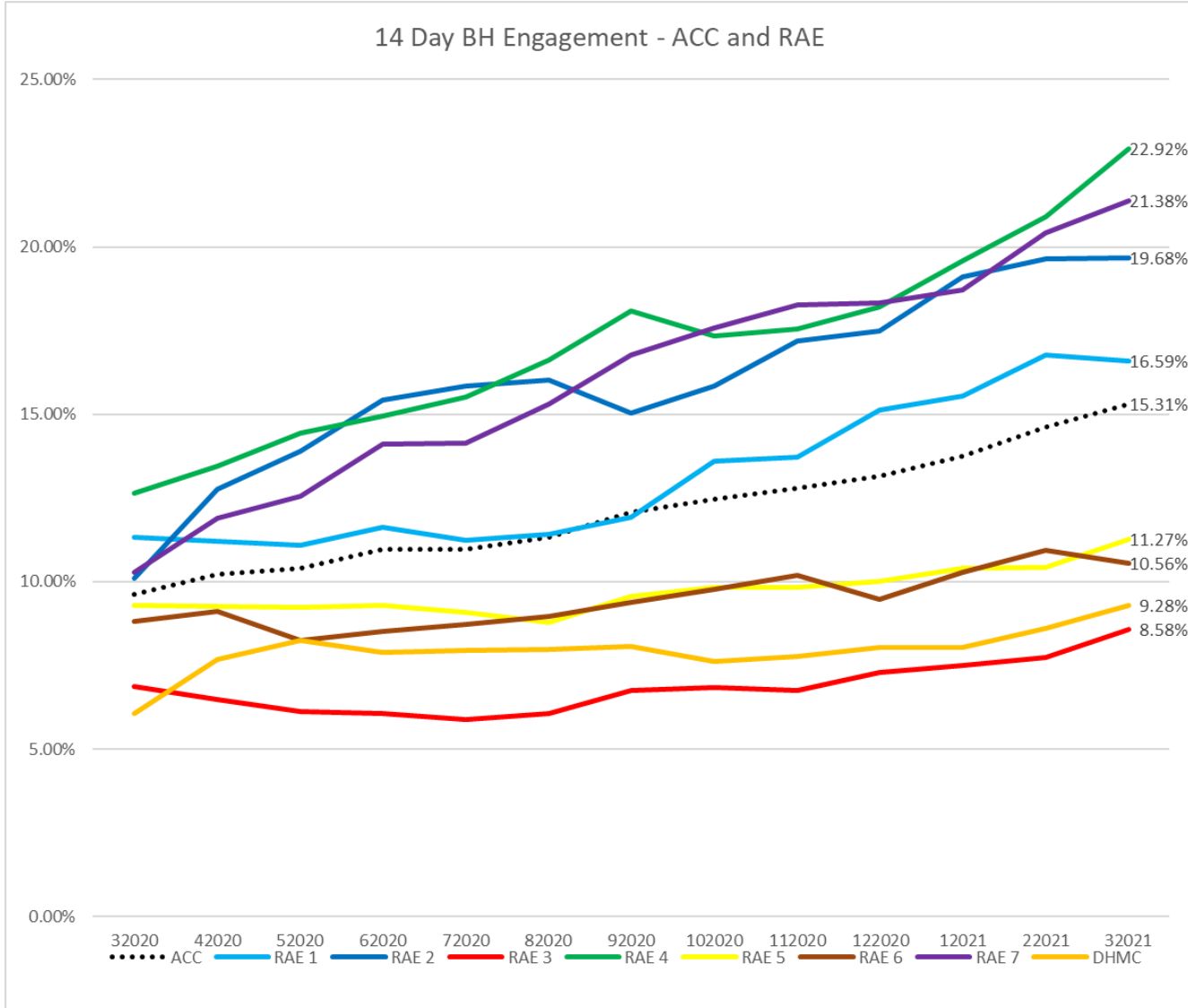


DOC Metric: Data and RAE Updates

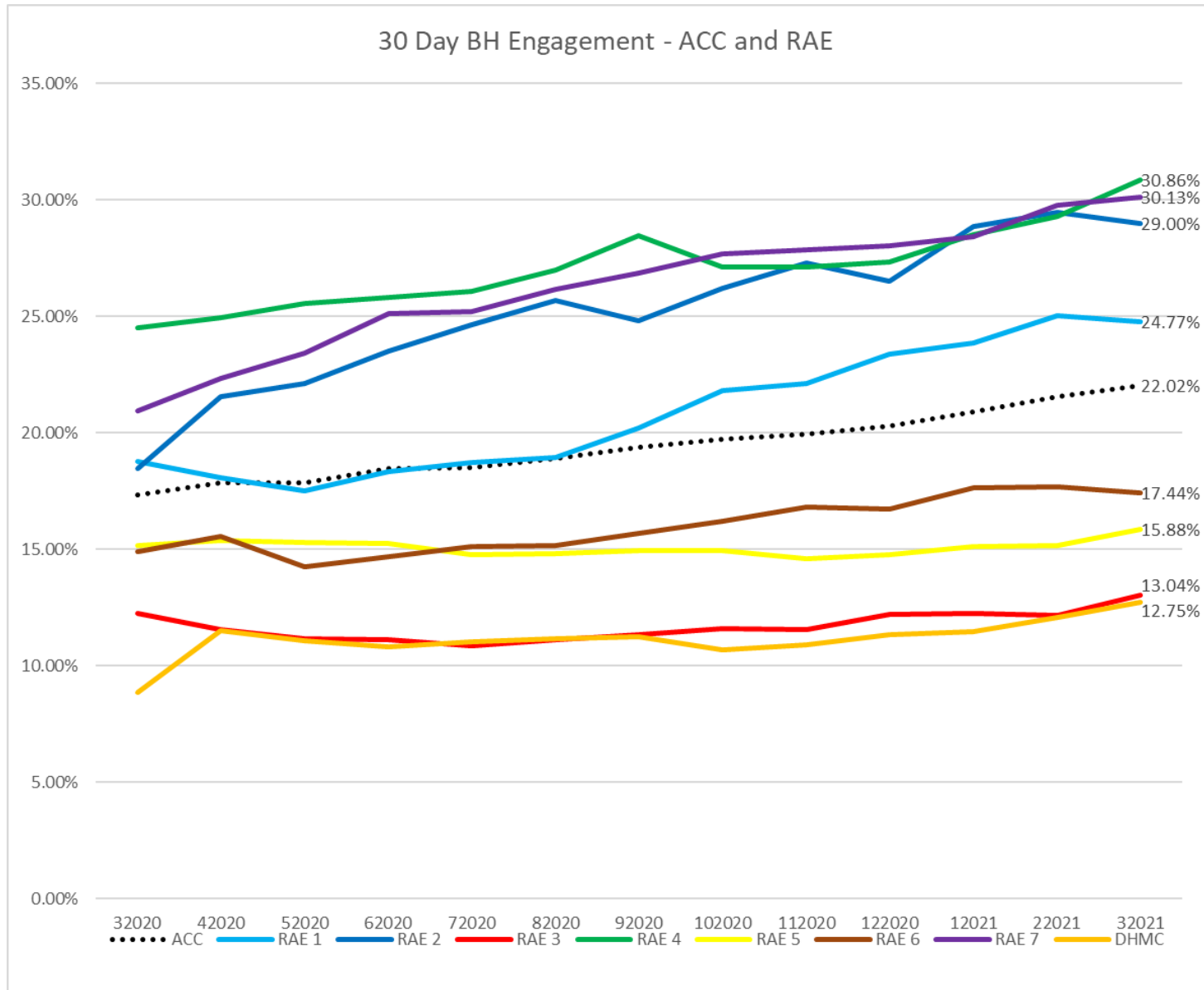


DOC Metric Review: March 2021 Data

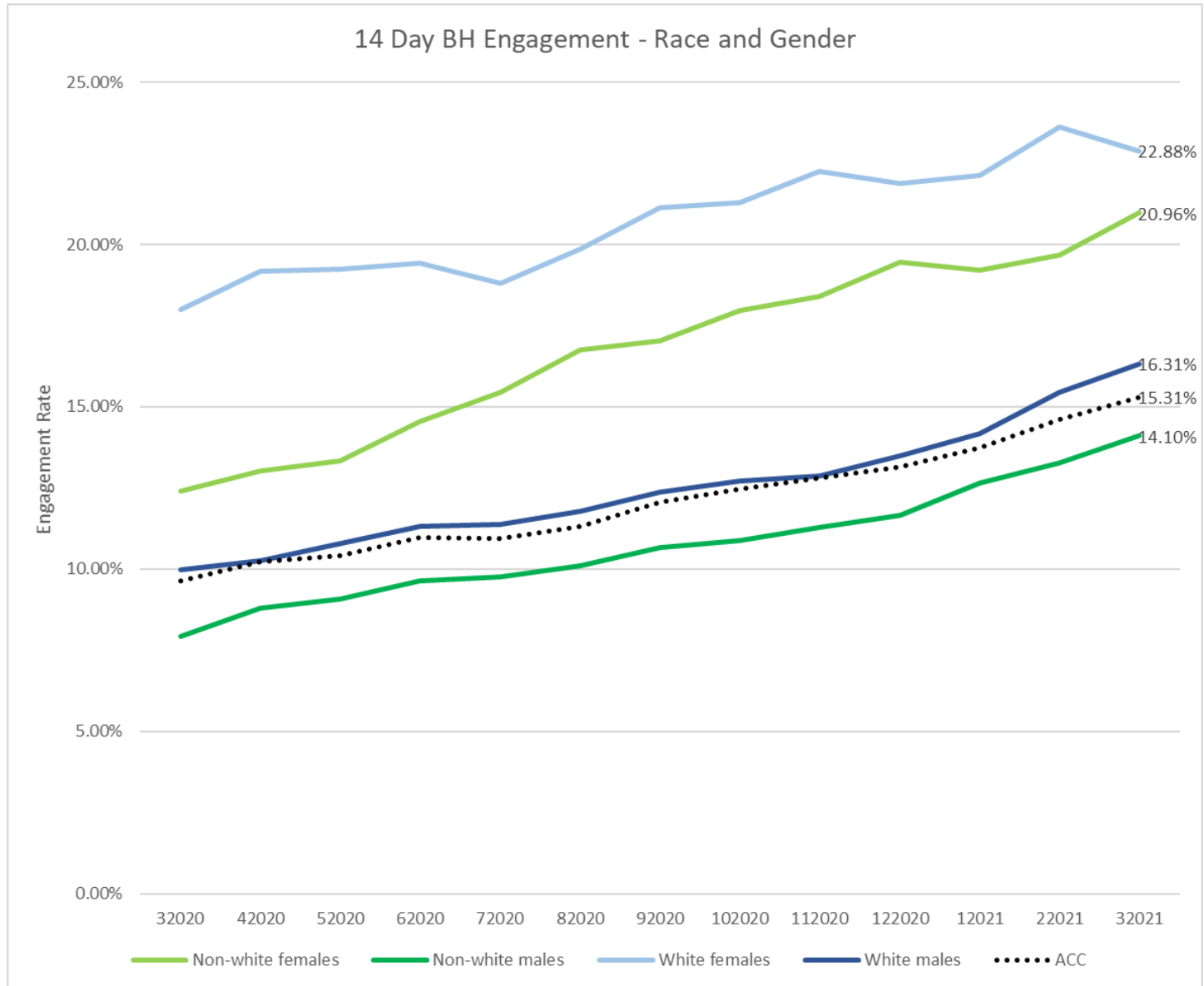
Medicaid Release Volume	Engagement Volume	Performance Rate	Target Rate	Difference (%)	Difference (Members)
7121	1090	15.31%	13.39%	1.92%	136



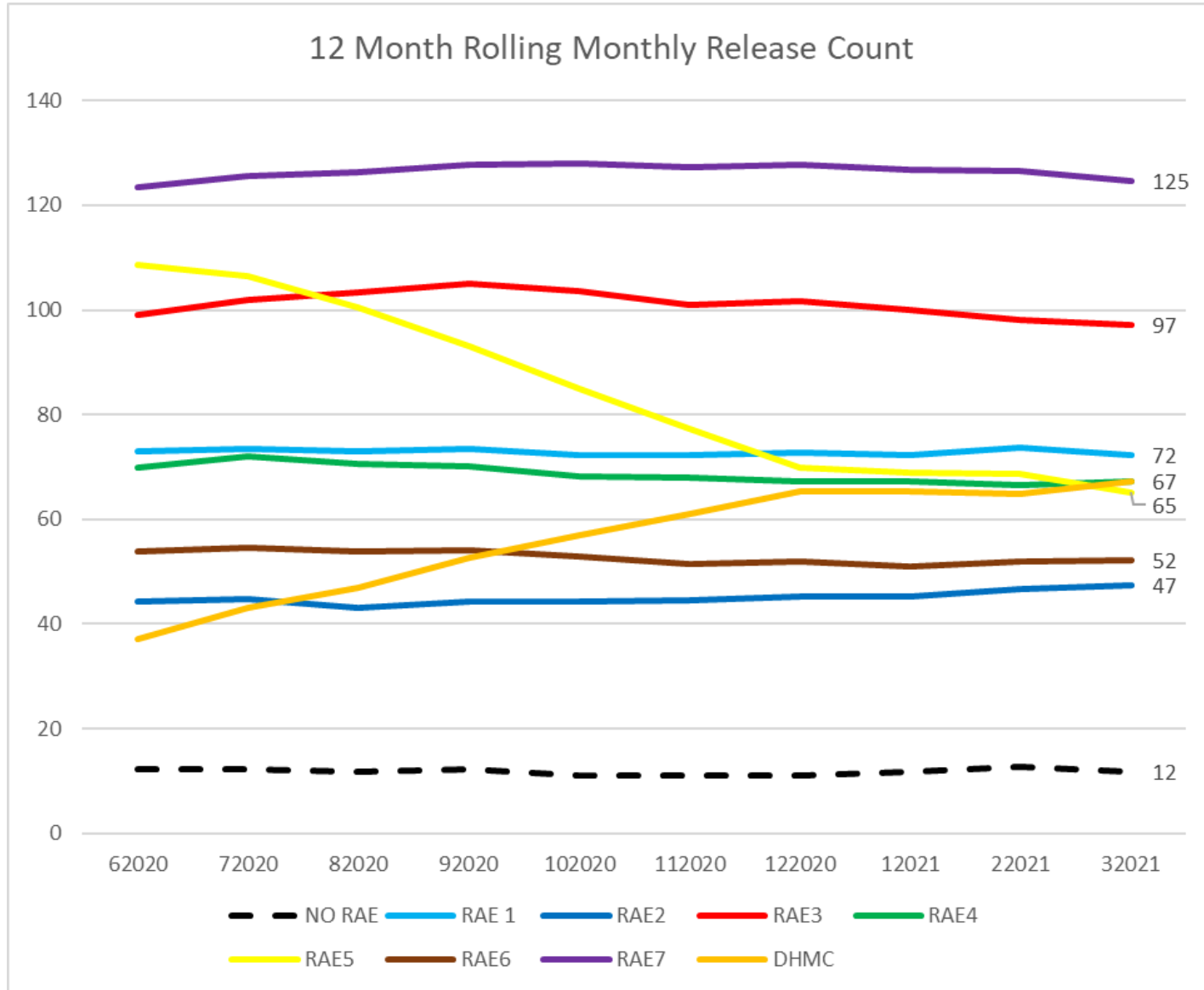
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CCHA's Engagement Strategies

General Outreach

- Triggered by Daily DOC Roster
(HCPF and DOC's data sharing)
- Cross-reference data sources
- DOC's treatment provider list
(scheduled BH appts)
- DOC's documentation platform *(contact information)*
- State Medicaid Portal
(primary care and RAE assignment)
- Via phone or leverage community partner

Community Corrections

(halfway houses)

- Co-Located to specific facilities
- MOU/BAA's in place to openly communicate and define roles
- CCHA focused on access to care and benefit utilization

Psychiatric In-Reach

- Applies to Region 6 only
- Piloting Jeffco and Boulder counties by connecting community BH Providers to DOC
- CCHA isn't currently participating
- Jefferson Center for Mental Health (JCMH) for Jeffco
- Boulder is pending

CCHA's Regional Differences

Region 7

Strong community partnerships

Higher number of releases but **more** streamlined systems (fewer entities)

Continue processes and partnerships

Resume in-person co-locations with Community Corrections



Region 6

Strong community partnerships

Lower number of releases but **less** streamlined systems (more entities)

Overlap with other RAEs

Connect community BH Providers to DOC and Community Corrections

Evaluate billing/funding barriers
