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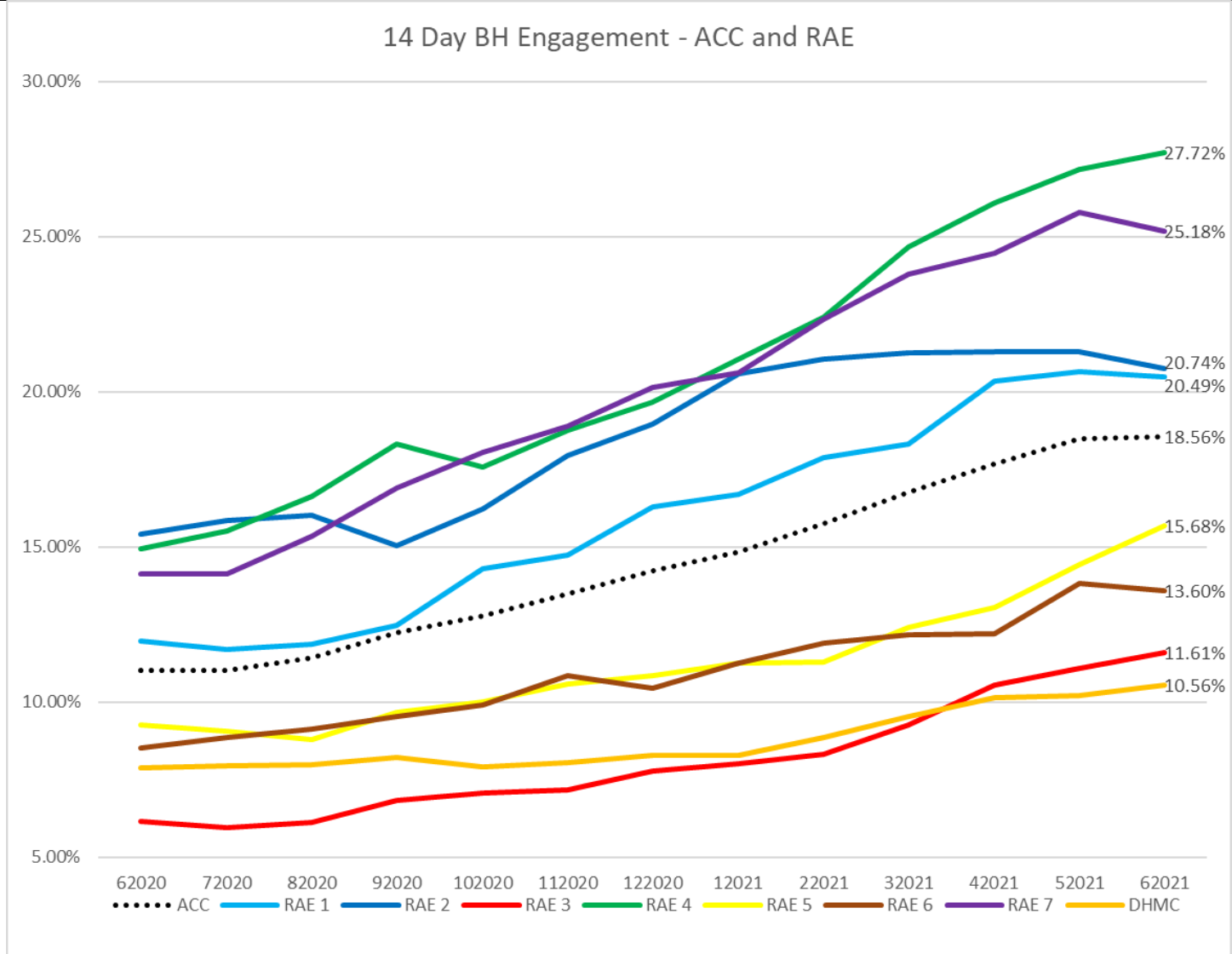
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COVID-19 Updates

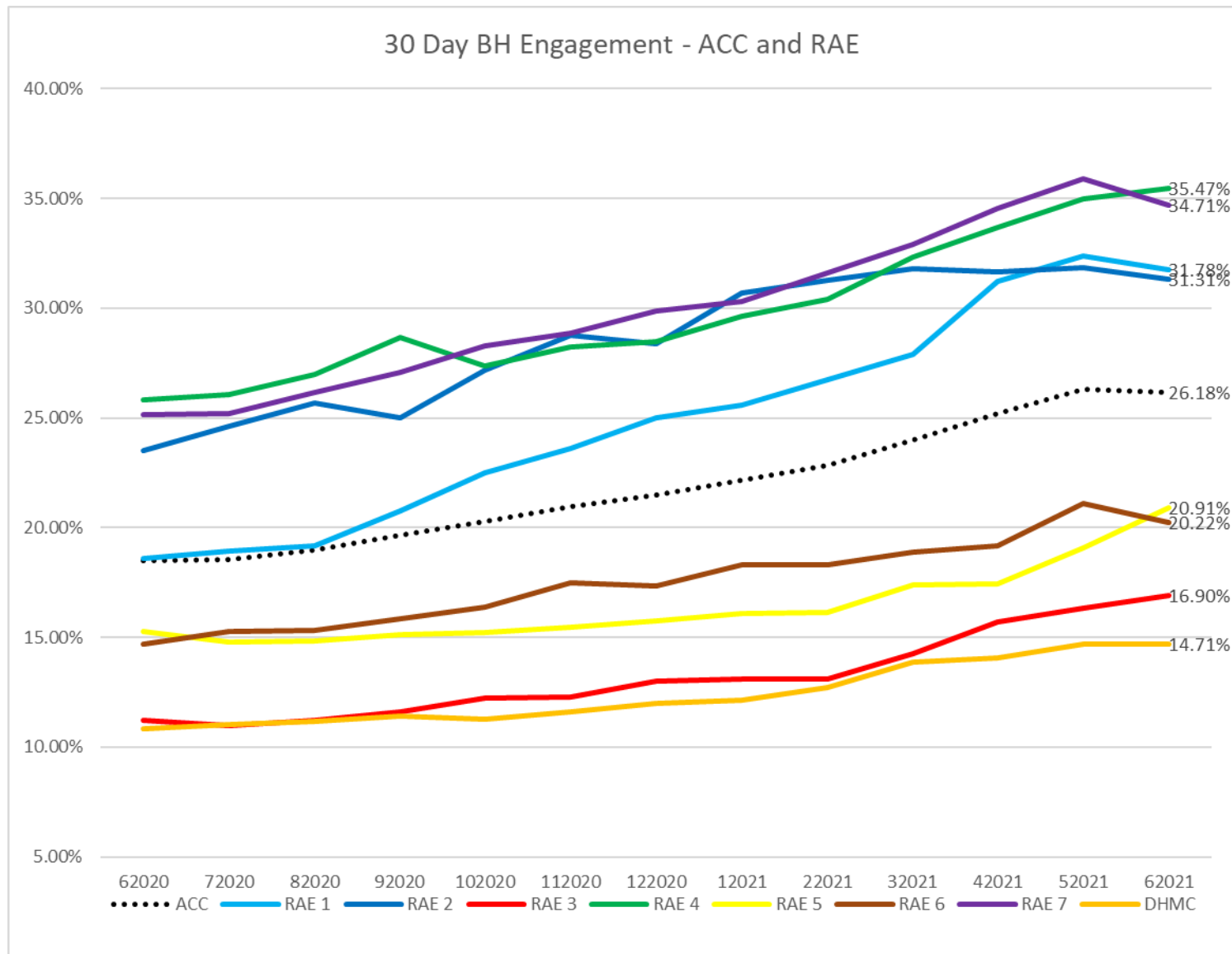
- Ongoing vaccine outreach and work to address disparities

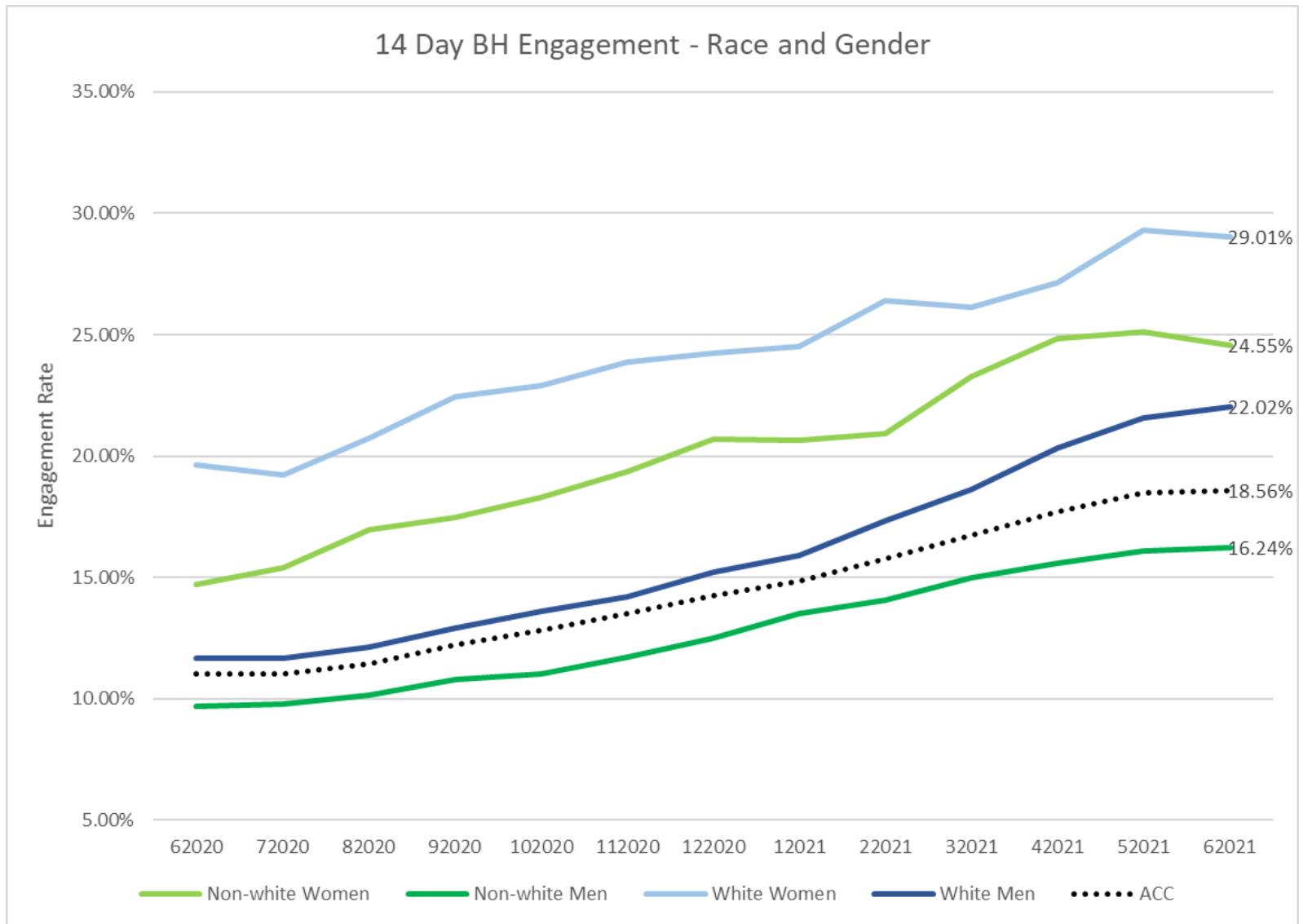
Medicaid Release Volume	Engagement Volume	Performance Rate	Target Rate	Difference (%)	Difference (Members)

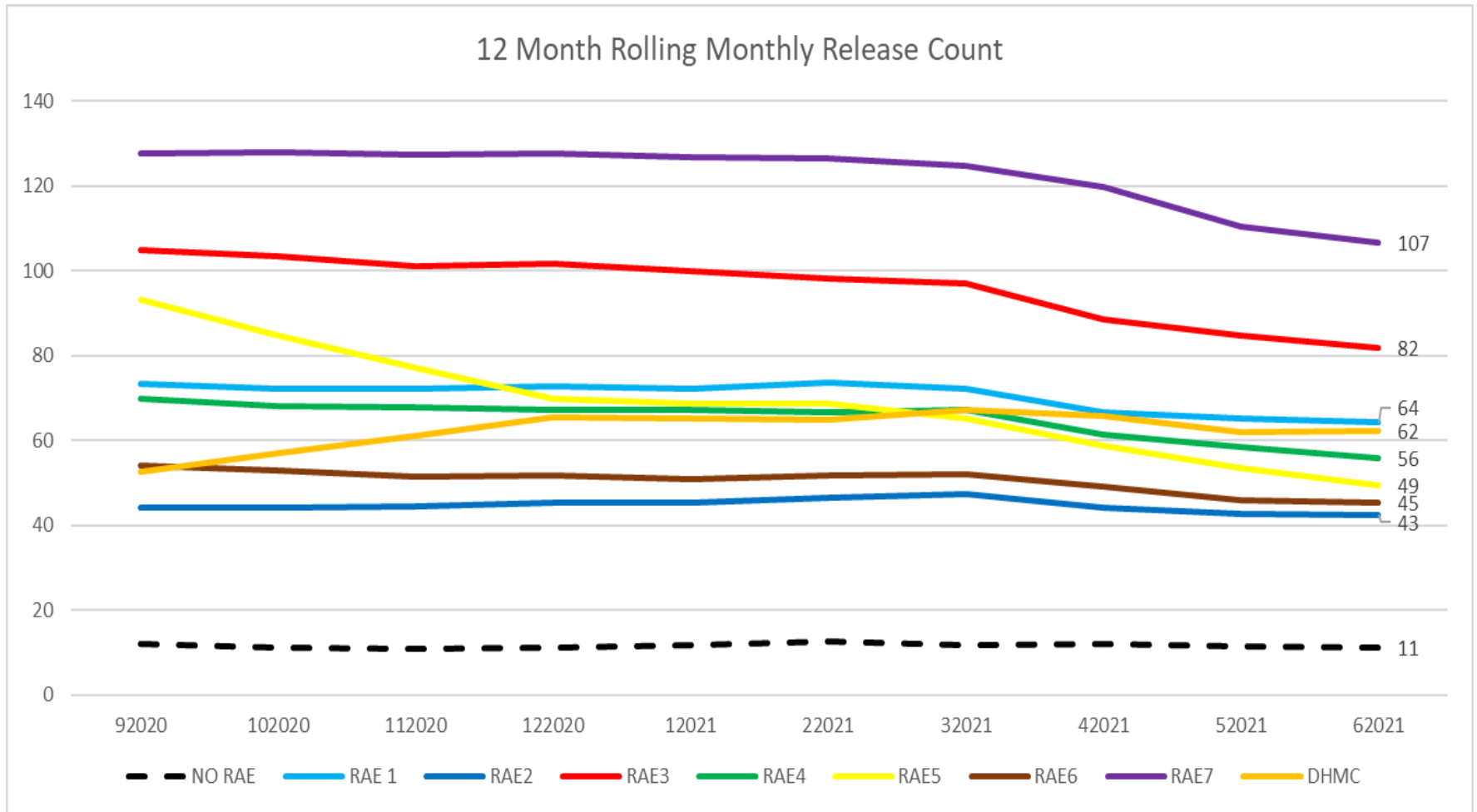
