COVID-19 Updates

- Public Health Emergency ended May 11, 2023
- Managing the end of the Public Health Emergency and the end of continuous enrollment is a Department Priority. Resources can be found at <u>hcpf.colorado.gov/covid-19-phe-planning</u>

End of Continuous Enrollment

- Colorado has been planning for the end of continuous enrollment and is working with CMS for ongoing approvals and reporting.
- Renewal notices started going out in March 2023 for members with renewals due in May 2023.
- Not all members will be renewed at the same time. Each member's renewal month will align with their already established annual renewal month.
- Colorado will take 12 months (14 months including noticing) to renew all 1.7 million members.



Preliminary DOC Metric Data

- Increasing confidence in the data accuracy, but most recent calculations delayed.
- FY21-22

Target Rate: 19.14%Tentative Result: 20.66%

- FY22-23 Target Rate: 22.08%
- August 2022 Tentative Result: 20.41%
- Rates will likely begin to be shared on a quarterly basis.



Legislative Updates with HCPF

I Matter Updates

- HB21-1258 created the program managed by the BHA that offers six free behavioral health services to youth in schools.
- HB22-1243: Extended the program through June 2024
- HB23-1003: Creates a school-based screening program managed by the BHA
 Schools without a health centers, with shortages of psychologists, and with high risk of student suicide
 BHA and HCPF work together to reimburse for covered services to eligible members
 - Path to services via I Matter if it is funded through FY24-25
