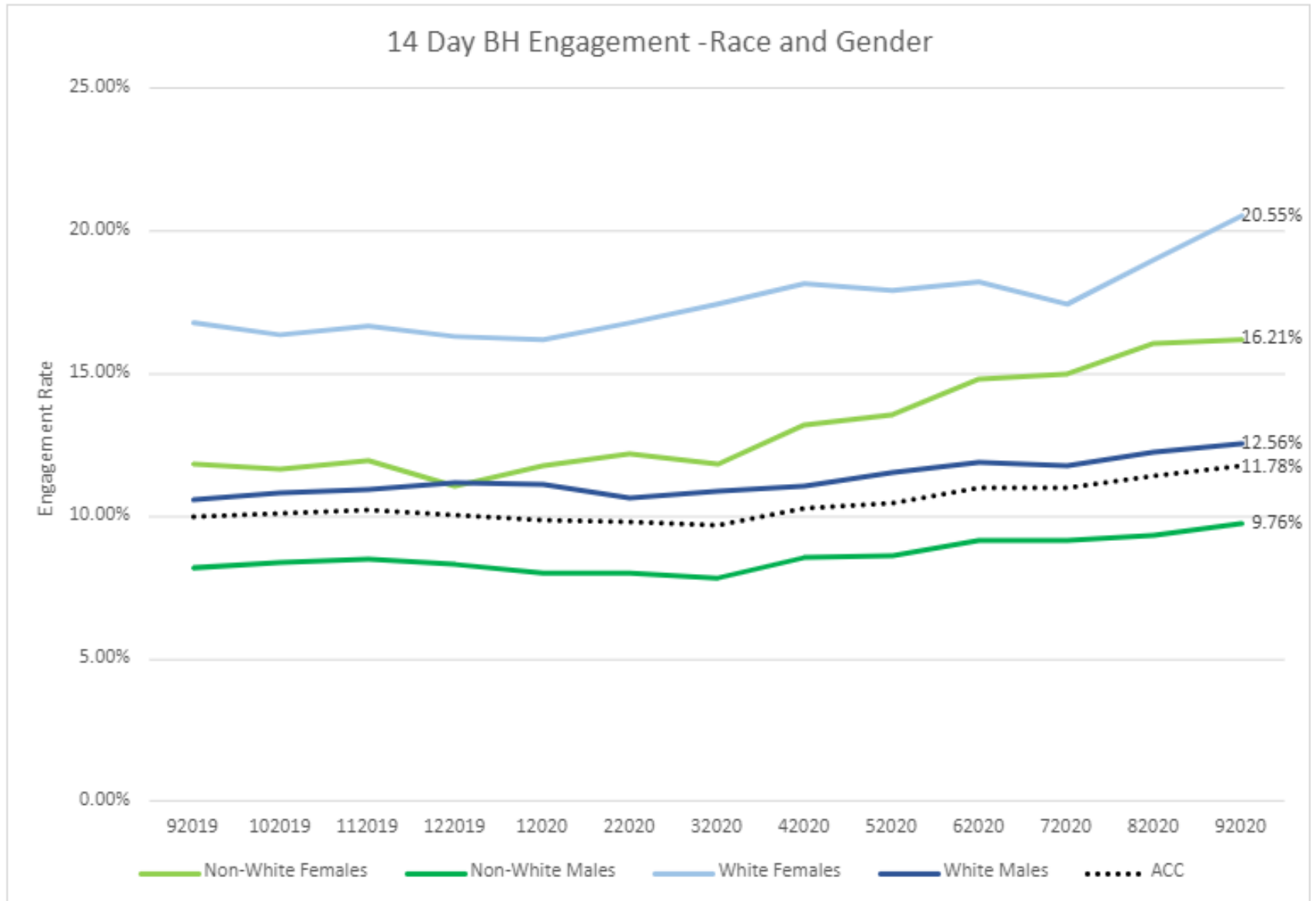

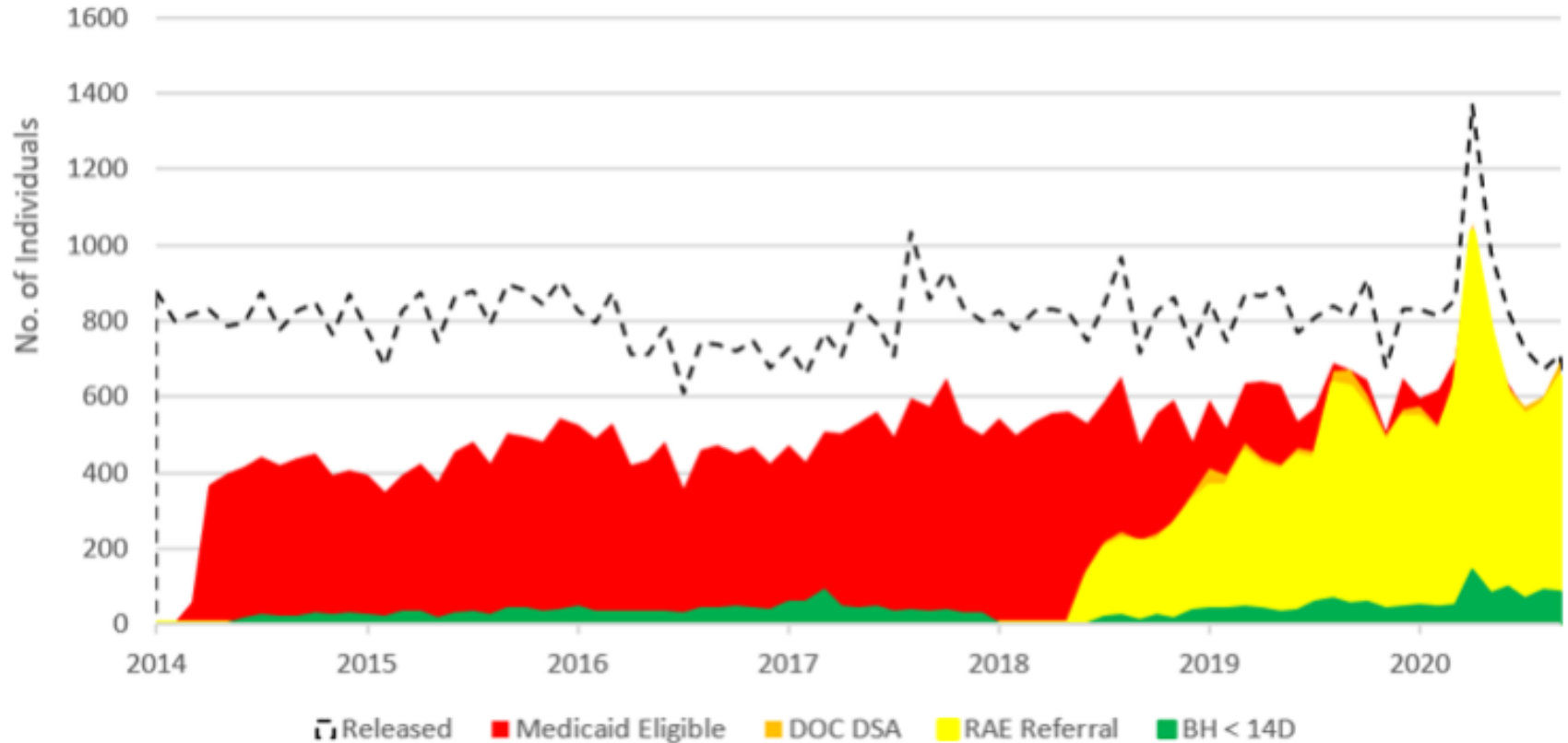

COVID-19 Updates

- Public Health Emergency Extended to April 20
- PHE will likely be extended in 90 day increments throughout 2021.
- HHS will provide states with 60 days notice when a decision is made to terminate the PHE or let it expire
- Updated Vaccine Phases
