What is a Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers are programs offering **services and benefits** to help people with **specific health conditions** live more independently in the community. Waiver programs give you

choice, control, and access to a full array of supportive services.



Brain Injury (BI) Waiver

If you have a **traumatic or acquired brain injury**, the Brain Injury Waiver provides **services and supports** allowing you to live in your **home or community**, rather than a hospital or nursing facility.

How can I get these services?

You may qualify if you:

- Are 16 or older
- Have a diagnosed brain injury which occurred before your 65th birthday
- Need **significant help with daily activities** like bathing, dressing or mobility
