



**ACC: Important Information for Primary
Care & Behavioral Health Providers**

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Provider Contracting

Beginning July 1, 2018, the next iteration of the Accountable Care Collaborative (ACC) is scheduled to begin. The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (the Department) awarded contracts to seven Regional Accountable Entities (RAEs). These entities will be responsible for developing and managing a network of primary care physical health providers and behavioral health providers. This function is currently provided by the Regional Collaborative Care Organizations (RCCOs) and Behavioral Health Organizations (BHOs).

All primary care providers who want to serve as a primary care medical provider (PCMP) and receive an Administrative Medical Home payment for Health First Colorado (Colorado’s Medicaid Program) patients must contract directly with the RAE(s). The Department will no longer make Per Member Per Month payments directly to PCMPs. Physical health services will continue to be reimbursed by the Department fee-for-service through the Colorado interChange.

Behavioral Health providers will need to contract with and be credentialed by the RAE to receive reimbursement for providing capitated behavioral health services as of July 1, 2018. Behavioral Health providers must be enrolled as a Health First Colorado provider before they can be credentialed by a RAE.

Note: Contracting with the RAE is handled separately from revalidation through the Colorado interChange. Health First Colorado providers with a current enrollment (meaning those providers who have successfully completed revalidation through the Colorado interChange) with the fiscal agent, DXC Technology (DXC), do not need to make changes to their enrollment to contract with the RAE(s).

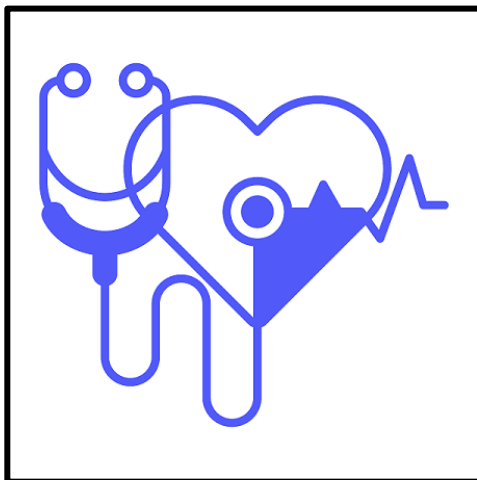
