CCBHC Planning Grant Goals

Colorado's participation in the CCBHC Planning Grant is a part of a state-wide, multi-agency effort to expand Colorado's behavioral health system of care.

The Planning Grant will allow HCPF and BHA to explore how the CCBHC model could complement the Colorado Safety Net System to promote integrated and accessible behavioral health care with sustainable funding practices.

Our goals:

- 1. Establish realistic implementation plan understanding cost and timeline.
- 2. Evaluate the CCBHC model to determine the best way to improve the Behavioral Health Safety Net system in Colorado

Provider Readiness Assessment 1/2

Action Items:

- Create a readiness tool that includes gap analysis
 - Provider level assessment and collection of macro level data
 - Utilize crosswalks to inform readiness tool
- Incorporate reporting requirements for both cost and quality metrics
- Establish a clear timeline for state review and response

Certification Process 1/2

Action Items:

- Develop state-specific CCBHC certification criteria
- Create a certification application process
 - Timeline
 - Submission
 - Site visit structure
- Create processes for provisional and full certification
- Evidence based practices and associated populations
- Compare CCBHC and Comprehensive Safety Net Provider requirements

Certification Process 2/2

9 Required Services:

- Crisis services
- Outpatient mental health and substance use services
- Person- and family-centered treatment planning
- Community-based mental health care for veterans
- Peer family support and counselor services
- Targeted care management
- Outpatient primary care screening and monitoring
- Psychiatric rehabilitation services
- Screening, diagnosis and risk assessment

Discuss:

- Designated Collaborating Organization (DCO) contracting
- Potential additional services
 - Opioid treatment program (OTP) and Walk-In Crisis (WIC)



Needs Assessment

- CCBHC are required to complete and utilize a needs assessment
- The needs assessment goal is to better inform service delivery and program design:
 - Staffing
 - o Language access
 - Service offerings
 - Operational hours
 - o Locations

Statewide Strategy

Future Action Items:

- Develop strategy to serve the goal number of individuals
- Develop process for bringing additional CCBHCs into the Demonstration program
- Provide the definition of the CCBHC service area
- Any other areas that go beyond the minimum expectations
- Develop plan to ensure multiple areas of diversity are defined and addressed
