Scope of Services

9 Required Services:

- Crisis services
- Outpatient mental health and substance use services
- Person- and family-centered treatment planning
- Community-based mental health care for veterans
- Peer family support and counselor services
- Targeted care management
- Outpatient primary care screening and monitoring
- Psychiatric rehabilitation services
- Screening, diagnosis and risk assessment

Crisis services requirements include:

- Walk-In Crisis (WIC)
- Mobile Crisis Response (MCR)

No-Cost Designated Collaborating Organization (DCO) contracting can be included for Crisis Services

Excluded services:

Opioid treatment program (OTP)



Scope of Services Changes

- Proceeding with SAMHSA's 9 core services including crisis service: Walk-In Crisis and Mobile Crisis Response
- No-Cost Designated Collaborating Organization (DCO) contracting can be included for Crisis Services
- Excluding Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) services at this stage
- OTP services may be revisited in future phases



Recommendation

Readiness Assessment:

 Does the current version of the Provider Readiness Assessment meet expectations and is it ready for Steering Committee review?

Scope of Services:

 Are we in favor of moving forward with implementing SAMHSA's 9 required services (including mobile and walk-in crisis services) with the removal of OTP at this time?



Quality Measure Requirement for Certification

- Certification will require submission of several data measures
- Initially proposed a few measures (noted below) that have recently come under review for alignment with goals
 - Time to Service (I-SERV)
 - Screening for Social Drivers of Health (SDOH)
- Group question: What does this group need/expect to support recommendation of the identified measures?
 - Goal: Move for recommendation in September, if possible
