CCBHC Planning Grant Goals

Colorado's participation in the CCBHC Planning Grant is a part of a state-wide, multi-agency effort to build and expand Colorado's behavioral health system of care.

The Planning Grant will allow HCPF and BHA to explore how the CCBHC model could complement the Colorado Safety Net System to promote Colorado's overall goal of integrated and accessible behavioral health care with sustainable funding practices.

Our goal is to determine the best way to implement CCBHC model standards in Colorado.

Current State: CSNP PPS

- CSNP: Comprehensive Safety Net Providers
- Current Colorado system allows for a Daily rate to be paid to providers each day a Health First Colorado member receives a triggering "service"
- Only one daily rate per person/per day
- This replaces the typical system that pays based on services rendered

PPS-1 vs. PPS-3

<u>PPS 1:</u> Daily Rate; Inclusion of Crisis Services in a single cost report

Pros:

- Very similar to CSNP PPS; the least technically complex change-over
- A single cost report for allowable costs under CCBHC requirements

Cons:

- Simple, not new
- May not incentivise quality-less likely to bundle care even if best for the member

PPS 3: Daily Rate; Separate cost reports to calculate separate PPS covering Crisis Services

Pros:

 Additional cost report may allow for more "fine-tuned" reimbursement

Cons:

 Properly done, a single cost report should appropriately and accurately capture expenditures, so an additional cost report would be duplicative and administratively burdensome

CSNP v CCBHC Scope of Service

CSNP

- Emergency and crisis behavioral health services
- Mental health and substance use outpatient services
- Behavioral health high-intensity outpatient services
- Care management
- Outreach, education, and engagement services
- Mental health and substance use recovery supports
- Outpatient competency restoration
- Screening, assessment, and diagnosis, including risk assessment, crisis planning, and monitoring to key health indicators

CCBHC

- Crisis Services
- Outpatient Mental Health and Substance Use Services
- Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services
- Targeted Care Management
- Person- and Family- Centered Treatment Planning
- Community-Based Mental Health Care for Veterans
- Peer Family Support and Counselor Services
- Outpatient Primary Care Screening and Monitoring
- Screening Diagnosis, and Risk Assessment

Potential Colorado Requirements:

- All current CSNP requirements plus:
- Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) Requirement
- Additional allowable Evidence Based Treatments (EBTs)
