July 2024-Sept 2024	• Stakeholder Engagement, Exploration, Grant Preparation
Aug 2024-Sept 2024	• Planning Grant Drafting
September 12, 2024	• Planning Grant Application Submitted to SAMHSA
December 1, 2024	• Anticipated Planning Grants Awarded
December 31, 2024	• Anticipated Grant Start Date
Jan 2025- Dec 2025	• Develop System Changes
October 2025	• CCBHC Certification Process Implemented
December 2025	• Demonstration Application Submitted to SAMHSA
December 30, 2025	• Planning Grant End Date
March 2026	• States Added to Demonstration Program

 - Identifying and acting on areas of improvement in Best Practices at all levels

CCBHC Engagement Expectation

"will meaningfully involve people with lived experience of mental health and substance use conditions (including youth and young adults), people being served by providers who will potentially be a part of the state CCBHC program, family members of people with lived experience, and communities..."
