2025 CCBHC Planning Grant

Colorado Grant Determination status:

- As of 12/2/24 Pending Council Review
- Top objectives:
 - > Exploration of choice and execution of PPS-1 methodology
 - > Defining Colorado specific regulation & requirements, standing up certification, and addressing organization readiness
 - Developing data collection and quality measurement policy and procedures
 - Determine if participating in the CCBHC Demonstration will be right for Colorado

CCBHC Stakeholder Engagement Plan Outline

- Quarterly Steering Committee
 - > Will include individuals with lived experience; engage in existing space
- Monthly Large Group Forum
 - > For all stakeholders at all levels interested in attending for updates and report outs
- Work Groups
 - > Monthly, fortnightly, or other cadence as needed for topic driven work groups
- *HCPF plans to engage a third-party vendor to help facilitate communication and stakeholder engagement.

CO CSNP PPS was LIVE July 1, 2024
