Eligibility - Targeted Criteria

No "cap"
or
waiting
list

Children and youth ages birth (0) through twenty (20):

- Determined to meet developmental delay/disability criteria
- Meets Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)(as defined in 42 CFR §440.150)
- Have extraordinary needs that put them at risk of, or in need of, out of home placement

 County custody or Child Welfare involvement is not required

Eligibility - Extraordinary Needs

- **Complex Behavior Supports:** Needs that occur related to a diagnosis by a licensed physician, psychiatrist, or psychologist that includes one or more substantial disorders of the cognitive, volitional or emotional process that grossly impairs judgment or capacity to recognize reality or to control behavior
- **Complex Medical Supports:** Needs that occur as a result of a chronic medical condition as diagnosed by a licensed physician that has lasted or is expected to last twelve (12) months, requires skilled care, and that without intervention may result in a severely life altering condition

Eligibility - Financial

- Parent's income not considered for Medicaid financial eligibility
- Social Security Income (SSI) not required
- Need SSI disability determination or Arbor application
- If child/youth is receiving Habilitation services, they will need an income source for room and board and likely need to apply for SSI financial eligibility

Inventory for Agency & Client Planning (ICAP)

- Tool used to determine reimbursement level for Habilitation
- Case Management Agency completes
- Respondents can be those who have known the individual for at least 3 months and sees them on a daily basis
- Maybe re-done at any time, at least annual review

Providers- Residential

- **Foster Care Home/Kinship Home**
 - Child Placement Agency(CPA)
 - Program Approved Services Agency (PASA) *only* if County Department of Human Services certifies Host Home as a Foster Care or Kinship Home
- **Host Home age 18-20**
 - PASA
- **Residential Child Care Facility**
 - Licensed by the Colorado Department of Human Services
- **Group Facility & Center**
 - CPA

Providers- Respite

- **Respite in the family home or community**
 - PASA approved to provide Respite in the Children's Extensive Supports (CES) waiver
- **Respite in a residential setting** (*same requirements as Habilitation*)
 - Foster Care Home
 - Residential Child Care Facility
 - Group Facility/Center
 - Host Home age 18-20

Providers- Community Connector and Professional Therapies

- **Community Connector (CC)**
 - PASA approved to provide CC for the Children's Extensive Supports (CES) waiver
- **Massage Therapy**
 - PASA approved to provide Massage Therapy for CES
- **Movement Therapy**
 - PASA approved to provide Movement Therapy for CES
- **Hippotherapy**
 - PASA approved to provide Hippotherapy for CES

Providers- Wraparound Facilitator and Child & Youth Mentorship

- **Wraparound Facilitator/ Child & Youth Mentorship**
 - Child Placement Agency
 - Medicaid Enrolled Provider
 - County Department of Human Services-Child Welfare
 - RCCF

Transition to Adult Services

- Youth may choose to transition out of CHRP from the age eighteen (18) through twenty (20)
- Youth must transition out of CHRP by age twenty-one (21)
- Youth may choose adult services that they are eligible for and that best meet their need
- The Developmental Disabilities (DD) waiver has reserved capacity for CHRP participants
- Transitions should occur when it is in the best interest of the youth
