# 4. CHASE Model Background - Nancy Dolson

- Brief overview of how the CHASE Provider Fee works
- Overview of the roles of HCPF and the CHASE Board



- Provider Fees
  - Fees are calculated on in-patient and out-patient services.
  - Fees are limited to 6% of net patient revenues.
  - Bob Vasil: Is the 6% of net patient revenue a state-wide limit?
  - Response to Mr. Vasil: It is statewide. We cannot collect fees that exceed
    6% or the net patient revenues for the State as a whole or for all
    providers that are subjected to the fee.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  The fees must be broad-based or uniform.
  - $\circ~$  A waiver does exist for either the broad-based or uniform requirements.
  - Jon: Is there a category or group set up under CHASE where some facilities are not paying the 6% resulting in the need for the waiver?
  - Reduced fees are charged on managed care days, high volume Medicaid and CICP hospitals.
  - Overview of the <u>CMS informational bulletin dated 2/17/2023</u>.
- CHASE Payments
  - Payments include Inpatient, Outpatient and DSH Allotment
  - Bob Vasil: Pointed out that the Board gets the final model in the same meeting that they're asked to vote on it. Is it possible to see the model a meeting prior to allow for more time to review it before the vote?
  - Nancy Dolson: Happy to take direction from the Board, and willing to do so. In the past, the analysts have presented their work to propose one model. Also willing to meet with any Board member who'd like a more in-depth review of the model in a separate meeting.
