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### Uniform Application Version 0.6

Version 0.6 of the Uniform Application has been uploaded to the [CICP Provider Information website](#). This version makes a few changes to Worksheet 1, including clarifying SSI as Social Security Income instead of Supplemental Security Income (this has also been updated in the provider manual for 2022-23), and adding a line in the Annual or One Time section for infrequent overtime. Please download this new version and begin using it at your earliest convenience.

### New Family Planning Program through Health First Colorado/CHP+

Providers are now advised to bill for family planning and related services as a covered Medicaid service under the new plan for members with expanded coverage. Eligible individuals can continue receiving discounted healthcare services through the CICP, but family planning and related services are covered by Health First Colorado. ### Emergency Medicaid

Beginning July 1, patients who qualify for Emergency Medicaid will keep their eligibility for 12 months. These patients are still eligible for CICP for any non-emergency services. CICP may not be used for services provided during the emergency episode of care that Emergency Medicaid denies.
