***Explanation of Intervention:**

Restrictive intervention may not be used for convenience or discipline. However, if the client needs emergency care, restraints may be used for brief periods to permit medical treatment to proceed. Also, if a resident’s unanticipated violent or aggressive behavior places him/her or others in imminent danger, restrictive intervention may be used. In this situation, the use of restraints is a measure of last resort to protect the safety of the resident or others and must not extend beyond the immediate episode.
