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Colorado Data Dictionary

Required Variables for Secure Transports, 2023

Each client should be entered on a unique row. Every column must be completed for all clients.

Secure Transportation Service Name

Definition: The secure transportation service's name as listed on county issued license.

Values: Free text appropriate service name

Unique Transport Number

Definition: The unique number automatically assigned by the service for each transport. This should be a unique number for the service for all of time.

Values: String between 3-50 characters

Transport Date

Definition: The date the responding unit began transport of the client.

Values: MM/DD/YYYY

Example: 12/01/2020

Client Age Group

Definition: The client's age group (either calculated from date of birth or best approximation).

Values: 18+
17 and under



Client Gender

Definition: The client's gender.

Values: Female
Male
Other, Non-binary
Unknown

Client Race

Definition: The client's race.

Values: American Indian or Alaska Native
Asian
Black or African American
Multiracial
Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
Other Race
White

Additional Information: Based on 2010 US Census Bureau. May be based upon self-report, identified by a family member, or medical record. If unable to confirm with client, then provider's best estimate may be used.

Client Ethnicity

Definition: The client's ethnicity

Values: Hispanic or Latino
Not Hispanic or Latino

Additional Information: Based on 2010 US Census Bureau. May be based upon self-report, identified by a family member, or medical record. If unable to confirm with client, then provider's best estimate may be used.



Client Residential Zip Code

Definition: The client's home ZIP/Postal code of primary residence.

Values: 5-digit ZIP code for US

Definition: Whether or not the client was on an involuntary hold (M1, M.5, and M8) during transport by the secure transportation service.

Definition: The ZIP/postal code of location the client was picked up or transferred from.

Physical Restraint Used During Transport

Definition: Whether or not a physical restraint was used on the client during transport by the secure transportation service.

Values: Yes

Additional Information: “Physical restraint”, for the purposes of secure transportation services means a physical device used to involuntarily restrict the movement of an individual or the movement or normal function of a portion of their body.

Serious Injury, Illness or Death During Transport

Definition: Whether or not a serious injury, illness, or death occurred during transport by the secure transportation service.

Values: Yes

Additional Information: Any secure transport resulting in the serious injury, illness, or death of a client or staff member during transport or resulting in injury to the client as a result of the use of physical restraint during transport shall be reported to the receiving facility immediately and to the county within twenty-four (24) hours of the incident in the manner and method determined by the county. Each report shall identify and describe the circumstances leading to the serious injury, illness, or death of a client or staff member during transport.

“Serious injury” means brain or spinal cord injuries; bone breaks or fractures; any injury that threatens life or limb, impairs the function of any part or organ of the body, or results in permanent disfigurement; burns of the second or third degree; and/or physical or sexual abuse as described in Article 3 of Title 18.
