

## **Principles Meet Practice: An Introduction to High Fidelity Wraparound**

## **Training:**

High Fidelity Wraparound is an evidence-informed, team-based planning model for children, youth, and families with complex needs across multiple systems. This training is for High Fidelity Wraparound Facilitators, Family and Youth Support Partners, and Supervisors to gain an introductory understanding of High Fidelity Wraparound and begin the path to credentialing. Participants will learn about and apply the wraparound principles, phases, and theory of change and practice the skills required by wraparound staff. To earn a certificate of completion, participants must attend all four days.

February 20-21 and March 19-20 in Boulder April 7-8 and 21-22 in Colorado Springs June 25-26 and July 16-17 in Boulder

- 1. Create an account; click on My Account (at the top of the website).
- 2. Register for and complete *Introduction to High Fidelity Wraparound (Web-Based Training)*. This is a two-hour pre-requisite training that must be completed before you can register for the four-day classroom training.
