# What is a Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers are programs offering **services and benefits** to help people with **specific health conditions** live more independently in the community. Waiver programs give you

**choice, control, and access to an array of supportive services.**



## Children's Habilitation Residential Program (CHRP) Waiver

If your child has an **intellectual or developmental disability or delay and complex needs**, CHRP can help them get services in their home or community.

### Services Available

  - Cognitive Services
  - Communication Services
  - Emergency Assistance Training
  - Independent Living Training
  - Personal Care Services
  - Self-Advocacy Training
  - Supervision Services
  - Transportation Services
- Community Connector
- Professional Services:
  - Hippotherapy
  - Massage
  - Movement Therapy
- Respite Services
- Wraparound Services
- Wraparound Facilitator
- Wraparound Plan
- Child & Youth Mentorship

# How can I get these services?

## Your child may qualify if they:

- Are age 0-20 with an intellectual or developmental disability or developmental delay if under age 5
- Are at risk of needing out-of-home residential services
- Require services similar to those provided in an institution for children with developmental disabilities
- Have complex needs, such as:
  - a medical condition lasting at least 12 months that may be life-altering if left untreated
  - a diagnosed behavioral disorder that significantly impairs judgment, limits ability to recognize reality, or results in out-of-control behavior



## If your child is a Health First Colorado member:

Contact your local Case Management Agency to see if your child qualifies for the CHRP Waiver.

A Case Management Agency (CMA) helps you see if this program is right for your child and helps you find services.

## If they're NOT a Health First Colorado member:

Contact your local CMA, or apply at [co.gov/PEAK](https://co.gov/PEAK)
