What is a Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers are programs offering **services and benefits** to help people with **specific health conditions** live more independently in the community. Waiver programs give you

choice, control, and access to a full array of supportive services.



Children's Home and Community-Based Services (CHCBS) Waiver

The CHCBS Waiver provides services and supports to **help your child with a disability** get the services they need in their home or community. A Case Manager helps you coordinate and manage your child's care.

Services Available

Case Management

- Assess child's long-term care needs
- Create an effective plan to meet those needs
- Coordinate with providers
- Re-assess child's needs regularly

In-Home Support Services

- Support with hygiene tasks, medical management, mobility needs and respiratory care
- Select, train, and manage attendants to best fit unique needs

How can I get these services?

Your child may qualify if they:

- Are **age 0-17** with a **disability** as defined by the Social Security Administration (SSA)
- Have **medical needs similar** to those provided in a **hospital or nursing facility**
- **Do not qualify** for other Health First Colorado programs because of excess income

A Case Management Agency helps you see if this program is right for your child and helps you find services.
