What is a Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers are programs offering services and benefits to help people with specific health conditions live more independently in the community. Waiver programs give you

choice, control, and access to a full array of supportive services.



Children's Home and Community-Based Services (CHCBS) Waiver

The CHCBS Waiver provides services and supports to **help your child with a disability** get the services they need in their home or community. A Case Manager helps you coordinate and manage your child's care.

Services Available

Case Management

- Assess child's long-term care needs
- Create an effective plan to meet those needs
- Coordinate with providers
- Re-assess child's needs regularly

In-Home Support Services

- Support with hygiene tasks, medical management, mobility needs and respiratory care
- Select, train, and manage attendants to best fit unique needs





How can I get these services?

Your child may qualify if they:

- Are age 0-17 with a disability as defined by the Social Security Administration (SSA)
- Have medical needs similar to those provided in a hospital or nursing facility
- Do not qualify for other Health First Colorado programs because of excess income

To apply:

Contact your local Case Management Agency (CMA)

A Case Management Agency helps you see if this program is right for your child and helps you find services.
