# APM 1 PY25 Consistencies

- Provider Enrollment Criteria
  - 500 or more attributed Medicaid Members
- Measure Selection Process
- Structural Measures
- Points Earned on Quality Measures
- Medicaid-Only eCQM Reporting Requirement
- Close the Gap Methodology
- FFS Rate Adjustments for PY24 and PY25\*

# Measure Menu

- Which measures will be included in the APM 1 PY25 Measure Selection?
  - ACC Measure Alignment, Structural Measures, PCMH Accreditation
- Will there be Mandatory Measures?
  - Yes - outlined on next slide.
- Will there be Roll-In Measures? If so what are they?
  - No. If a PCMP cannot report on one or more of the mandatory measures please work with your RAE and HCPF to discuss alternative options
- Are there denominator requirements for APM 1 measures?
  - Admin Measures: PCMPs must have a denominator of 30 and close the gap to earn up to full points
  - eQMs: denominator requirements and available points will remain the same

## Adult Measure Set

- Controlling High Blood Pressure (Admin/eCQM) - Mandatory Measure
- Screening for Depression and Follow-Up Plan (Admin/eCQM) - Mandatory Measure
- Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients with Diabetes (Admin/eCQM) - Mandatory Measure
- Breast Cancer Screening (Admin/eCQM)
- Cervical Cancer Screening (Admin/eCQM)
- Chlamydia Screening in Women (Admin/eCQM)
- Contraceptive Care - All Women (Admin)
- Colorectal Cancer Screening (eCQM)

## Pediatric Measure Set

- Childhood Immunization Status Combination 10 (Admin/eCQM) - Mandatory Measure
- Screening for Depression and Follow-Up Plan (Admin/eCQM) - Mandatory Measure
- Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (Admin) - Mandatory Measure
- Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits (Admin) - Mandatory Measure
- Immunizations for Adolescents Combination 2 (Admin) - Mandatory Measure
- Chlamydia Screening in Women (Admin/eCQM)
- Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life (Admin)
- Contraceptive Care - All Women (Admin)



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# Target Setting and Quality Performance

- Will PCMPs still need to Close the Gap for PY25? Yes, with a change in the HCPF Statewide Goal.
  - Previous: PCMP must Close the Gap to the 90<sup>th</sup> Percentile
  - New: PCMPs must Close the Gap to the 75<sup>th</sup> Percentile
- Will FFS Rate Changes Occur for PY24 and PY25?
  - PY24: FFS rate changes will occur based on 2024 quality measure performance and we will utilize the close the gap at the 75<sup>th</sup> Percentile.
  - PY25: FFS rate changes will occur based on 2025 quality measure performance and we will utilize the close the gap at the 75<sup>th</sup> Percentile.\*

\*HCPF is still determining how to best pay out for PY25 performance, this is subject to change as we determine the best way forward with ACC Alignment

# APM 2

- When will PMPM rate updates be available for PY25?
  - PMPM rate updates have been finalized for participants 1/1/25
- When will Chronic Condition thresholds be available for PY25?
  - Scheduled to be shared in January
- When will Chronic Condition Results be available for PY23?
  - Early 2025
- What will happen to my PMPM if the Access Stabilization Payments are approved by the legislature for ACC 3.0?
  - Participants will no longer receive the 16% rate increase in APM 2. We will work with participants on specific rate impacts as soon as possible
