




Metric: Behavioral Health Engagement for Members Releasing from State Prisons


- Part of the <u>Performance Pool</u> incentive funds
- Definition: Percentage of members releasing from a Department of Corrections (DOC) facility with at least one billed behavioral health capitated service or short-term behavioral health visit within fourteen (14) days.
- Statewide metric
- Six (6) month delay for claims runout


- Initial rate in June 2019 was 9.02%
- The target for FY21-22 was 19.13%
- The actual rate for FY21-22 was 20.67%
- The target for FY22-23 was 22.08%
- The actual rate as of December 2022 was 20.38%

















- General trends appear to be a leveling of releases and engagement.
- DOC continues to be an important partner. Staffing challenges have been a barrier.
- Some return to in-person coordination from RAE staff
- RAEs have initiated some additional outreach that probably hasn't shown up in the data yet.
- MOVEit outage was a disruption to coordination
