# What is a Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers are programs offering **services and benefits** to help people with **specific health conditions** live more independently in the community. Waiver programs give you

**choice, control, and access to a full array of supportive services.**



## Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver

This waiver can provide you with **access to 24-hour support for your intellectual or developmental disability** and help you **live in your home or community.**

### Services Available\*

- Behavioral Services
- Day Habilitation Services (Specialized Habilitation, Supported Community Connections)
- HCBS Dental Services
- Home Delivered Meals
- Non-Medical Transportation
- Peer Mentorship
- Prevocational Services
- **Residential Habilitation Services (individual, group, or family)**
- Specialized Medical Equipment and Supplies
- Supported Employment
- Transition Set Up
- Vision Services

\* There is a waiting list to receive services.

# How can I get these services?

## You may qualify if you:

- Are 18 or older with an intellectual or developmental disability
- Require access to services 24 hours a day
- Need long-term support services like those provided in a facility for adults with developmental disabilities

## If you are a Health First Colorado member:

Contact your local Case Management Agency to see if you qualify for the Developmental Disabilities Waiver.

A Case Management Agency (CMA) helps you see if this program is right for you and helps you find services.
