Step 1. Acquire a National Provider Identifier (NPI) A Type 1 NPI will be required when registering as a Doula. ♦ Apply for a Type 1 Individual NPI through the NPPES website

Step 2. Gather Necessary Documents and Information - Review Forms for doulas

Step 3. Complete the Application

Once Steps 1 and 2 are complete, it is now time to complete the HFC doula provider application.

◆ Complete the application online: Provider Enrollment - click enrollment information by provider type - Doula

 Submit the verification documentation requested.

Step 4. Complete Background check

◆ Once your application is submitted, it will trigger a request for a background check, you will have 30 days to complete your fingerprinting, the ATN aka 'application tracking number" will be associated with your CBI report.

Fingerprinting: scroll down page for more info.

 Notification of acceptance depends on several factors. If an application is returned to the provider for additional information, prompt responses can prevent further delays. Approval timelines vary based on how guickly the provider submits the requested information and schedules a site visit.

 Once approved, notification will be sent to the contact information provided in the enrollment application confirming the approval. At this point you are an approved enrolled HFC provider.
