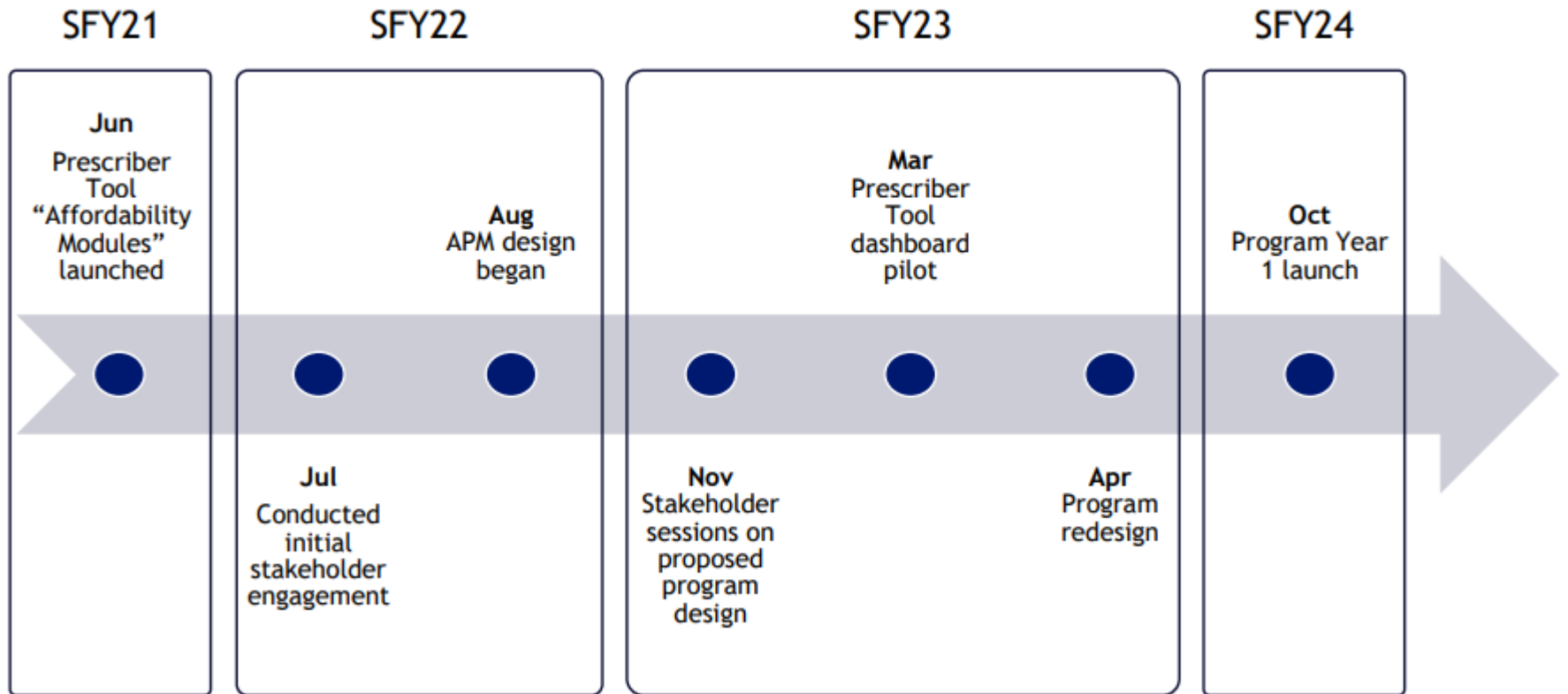

Performance Dashboards

- Hosted on a secure webpage accessible only to participating practices.
- Accessible and presents data per practice NPI.
- Serves as access point for the survey required for incentive payment eligibility.
- Displays data for each of the four quarters of State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2022-2023.
- Facilitates communication and transparency with data that will eventually inform incentive payment decisions.



Getting Started

1. Each practice receives two emails from the dedicated email address: corxapm@mslc.com.
 - The first is an introductory message that includes a program overview and contact information for technical issues.
 - The second is practice-specific and includes login credentials (username and password).
2. The username for each practice is its 10-digit National Provider Identifier (NPI).
3. The password is a uniquely assigned 10-digit code, which cannot be changed. Lost or forgotten passwords may only be retrieved by contacting the dedicated email address.

Prescriber Tool Alternative Payment Model (APM)

The Colorado Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) has implemented a prescription benefit tool to promote cost-effective prescribing of Medicaid-covered outpatient drugs. The Prescriber Tool is a multifunctional platform accessible to prescribers through most electronic health record (EHR) systems. The Prescription Benefit modules, also referred to as the Affordability modules, of the Prescriber Tool promote cost-effective prescribing for Health First Colorado members by supporting the prescribing of affordable medication alternatives, the pricing for which has already taken into account the fiscal benefit of federal and supplemental pharmacy rebates available to HCPF.

The Prescriber Tool offers three key features:

- Real-Time E-Prescribing: Prescribers can now send prescriptions electronically to pharmacies for Medicaid patients, increasing convenience and saving time for patients, prescribers and pharmacies.
- Real-Time Benefits Inquiry (RTBI): Prescribers now have rapid insight into preferred medications from the preferred drug list, empowering them with drug affordability and cost options.
- Real-Time Prior Authorization: Prescribers can now get rapid prior authorizations, reducing workload and avoiding manual entry, forms, faxes and lists.



Prescriber Tool APM Data Validation Survey and Training

Completion of this form is a requirement of the Prescriber Tool Alternative Payment Model (APM) program. This form supports engagement with provider-facing dashboards that display data on provider Preferred Drug List compliance and provider usage of the Real-Time Benefits Inquiry (RTBI) module of the Prescriber Tool. The Department is requesting feedback on the perceived accuracy of the RTBI use metric to ensure its validity for future program years when it will inform shared savings eligibility under this program.

This form should take 15-20 minutes to complete and must be completed in one attempt.

Completion is required to receive an incentive payment through Prescriber Tool APM program.

This form can be completed by a prescriber or a practice manager, but the individual must be knowledgeable about the use of the RTBI module in their practice in order to provide feedback about metric accuracy.

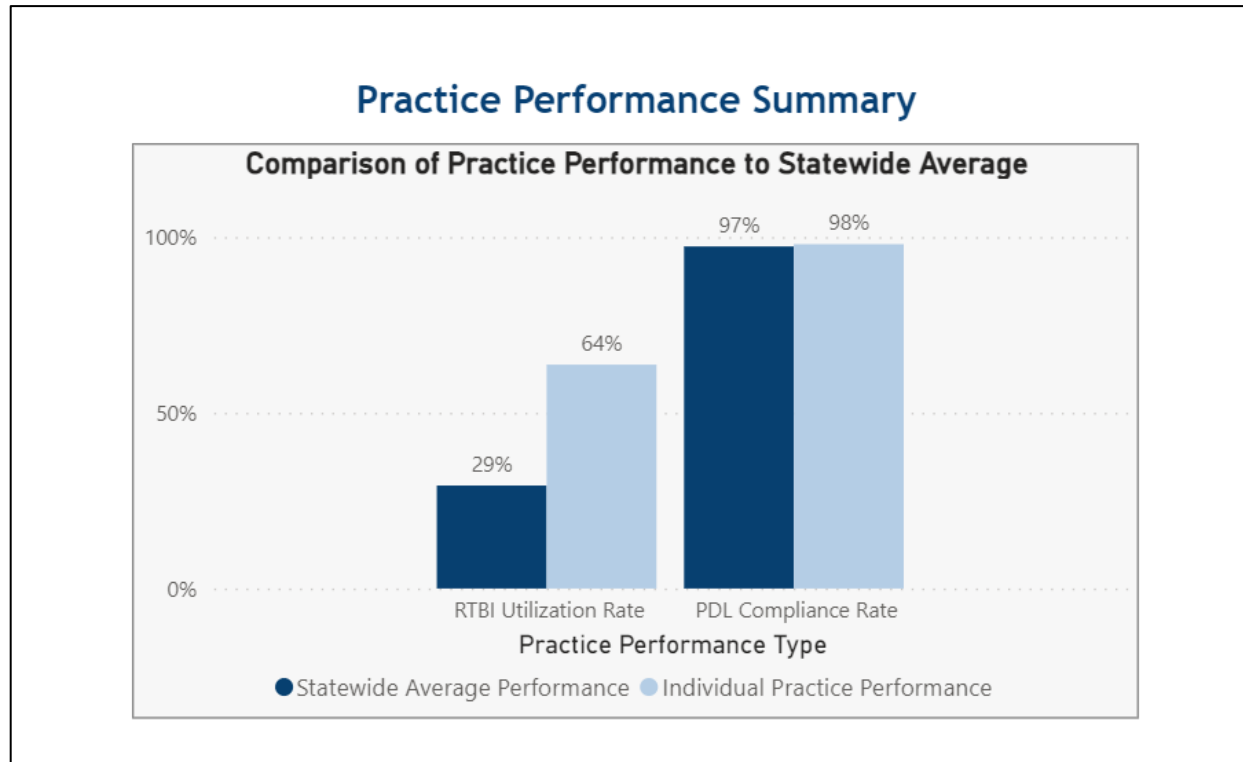
