

Lactation Benefit Duration

- What are your thoughts on the duration of this covered benefit?
 - Pregnancy and the extended postpartum period (1 year after pregnancy ends)
 - Women's Preventive Services Initiative (WPSI) recommends during pregnancy and postpartum period up to 24 months or longer
 - Postpartum period up to 24 months to align with Colorado laws supporting breastfeeding
 - Offer lactation support services without age restrictions if deemed medically necessary



Number of Visits

- What is your opinion on the optimal number of lactation visits that can be billed?
 - Some states allow up to 6 visits
 - Some states impose specific limits for individual, group, and telehealth settings
- How about different settings such as group education classes, support groups, home visits, clinic visits, and virtual support?
- Could you please tell us how long a typical lactation visit usually lasts?



Communication

 What are some potential strategies to effectively communicate the lactation services benefit to members/providers?


