### **Purpose and Audience:**

The purpose of this Informational Memo is to inform Community Centered Boards (CCB) about the transition of Level II Evaluations to a new vendor as part of the Pre-Admission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) process.

### **Information:**

Currently, staff within CCBs are responsible for conducting Level II Evaluations as part of the PASRR process, as laid out in CCB contracts. As of September 1, 2019, the Level II Evaluations for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) will be conducted by the Department of Health Care Policy & Financing's (Department) vendor, eQHealth.

**Effective September 1, 2019, CCBs shall not conduct any Level II Evaluations.** The Department will not reimburse a CCB for a Level II Evaluation conducted on or after September 1, 2019. If a CCB has any pending Level II Evaluations, they must be completed by August 31, 2019. The Department has contacted any CCB with pending Level II Evaluations.

**The CCB remains responsible for conducting any Developmental Disability Determinations needed as part of the PASRR process, to include the**

**Psychological Evaluation when necessary.** The Department is in the process of distributing contract amendments to all CCBs for signature to remove the Level II Evaluation requirement.
