Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Informational Memo is to inform and invite stakeholders to the stakeholder engagement meetings for Case Management Redesign (CMRD) rule revisions. This memo also updates the previous communication due to changes that were made in the CMRD Rule Revision Meeting Topics schedule.

Background:

CMRD refers to several initiatives aimed at simplifying access to long-term services and supports (LTSS), creating stability for the case management system, increasing and standardizing quality requirements, ensuring accountability, and achieving federal compliance. CMRD was initiated in 2014 with a Governor's Executive Order and recommendations from the Community Living Advisory Group (CLAG) that requires Colorado to come into compliance with the federal requirements for case management

and create a more simplified system. The Department passed HB 21-1187 to achieve the goals of CMRD.

Information:

CMRD HCBS Rules Changes

The Department will update rules and regulations pertaining to Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waivers and non-waiver programs to come into alignment with new CMRD statute, policy, and language. Rule updates are required to clean up areas in existing rule and waivers that are repetitious, obsolete, or difficult to follow and understand. CMRD also implements changes to the rule structure. The vision behind the structure change is to make the HCBS rules easier to find, read and understand for all stakeholders. Rules must be in effect no later than Nov. 1, 2023, at which point the first cohort of new Case Management Agencies under CMRD will transition.

The Department would like to hear from stakeholders about each of the rule revision topics listed below to ask questions and receive feedback based on your knowledge and experience with navigating HCBS rules to help us make these rule revisions work for all HCBS stakeholders. The Department will post the section of rule or waiver to be discussed on the CMRD webpage one week prior to each meeting. Stakeholder engagement, feedback and Department responses will be tracked through both the listening logs and issues for further discussion logs posted to the CMRD webpage.

To provide comments, questions or concerns, stakeholders may attend the meetings as scheduled on the CMRD webpage and provide feedback via chat or verbally. If stakeholders are unable to attend the meetings, but wish to provide feedback, they may email the CMRD team members directly. Comments sent directly to the team will be documented in the listening log and responded to using the same process for comments received in the meeting.
