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Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Informational Memo- is to inform Targeted Case Management - Transition Coordination (TCM-TC) providers of the guidelines regarding submission of claims and utilization of TCM-TC units for travel related to the provision of transition coordination activities.

Information:

Pursuant to state and federal regulations guidance, listed below, travel related to the provision of transition coordination activities is not an allowed targeted case management activity. Use of and billing TCM-TC units for travel is not allowable. An exception of this is made for rural/frontier travel as outlined below.

Reimbursement for rural/frontier travel for provision of in-person TCM-TC services is allowable under the following circumstances:

1. TCM-TC services is being provided by a TCA located in the rural/frontier region. An exception to this is allowed if there is not a TCA located in the rural/frontier region.
2. Provision of TCM-TC services requires travel of 100 or more miles (one way).
3. Travel time is allowed from the local TCA site to the location where services will be provided.

Reimbursement for TCM-TC rural/frontier travel will be made in accordance with guidelines provided in the Targeted Case Management - Transition Coordination (TCM-TC) Services Billing Manual.
