### Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Informational Memo is to inform Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waiver members and Case Management Agencies (CMA) of updated fare structures and rates for public transit rides through the Regional Transportation District (RTD). Effective Jan. 1, 2024, RTD’s Local and Regional fare zones have been combined, creating a streamlined process for determining scheduled rides at a reduced fare cost.

#### RTD Discounted Fare Updates

HCBS members enrolled on an adult waiver are eligible to receive the discounted fares. Discounted fares are also available to seniors 65 and older, individuals with disabilities, and Medicare recipients. Proof of eligibility is required for all passengers

using discounted fare products. A Special Discount Card will be issued upon eligibility approval.

Multiride pass booklets are still offered. A 10-ride ticket book for 3-hour rides will now cost \$13.50, and a 6-ride ticket book for Access A Ride will be \$27.00.

Please note that riders aged 19 and under will continue to ride for free under the ZERO Fare for Youth pilot program, which ends on Aug. 31, 2024.
