## **Purpose and Audience:**

The purpose of this Operational Memo is to inform Case Management Agencies of a temporary increase to the rates paid for Case Management services.

## Information:

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (Department) has approved a temporary rate increase of 2.11% for Case Management services <u>billed through the</u> <u>Colorado InterChange Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS)</u>. The services subject to this increase are:

- Case Management services for the Children's Home and Community-Based Services Waiver (CHCBS)
- Targeted Case Management Transition Coordination (TCM-TC)
- Targeted Case Management Per Member, Per Month

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- Targeted Case Management Monitoring Visit
- Targeted Case Management Monitoring Visit, Rural Add On

This increase is applicable from April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023.

Fee Schedules located on the Department's <u>Provider Rates and Fee Schedule webpage</u> have been updated to reflect the increased rate for each of the identified services.

This funding is part of an overarching effort to leverage the HCBS ARPA funds to stabilize and increase the direct care workforce. The purpose of this funding is to support hiring and retention efforts.
