Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Operational Memo is to provide Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) providers with the Direct Care Worker (DCW) base wage increase information, the targeted base wage rate increase, the process to demonstrate compliance with the wage increase, and the corrective action steps for those providers who do not meet the reporting deadline.

Information:

Effective July 1, 2024, all impacted DCWs, employees or independent contractors, are required to be paid at a minimum the \$17.00 per hour base wage outside of Denver or \$18.29 within Denver in alignment with the Denver minimum wage increase. Additionally, Direct Care Workers, who are paid a per diem rate for a specific service,

must have their rate increased by the same percentage of the base wage rate increase for the specific service listed on the HCBS Rates Schedule as of July 1, 2024. Please note that the 2% across the board rate increase that also takes effect on July 1, 2024, is a separate increase that is not included in the DCW per diem rate increase.

- Host Home (CHRP)
- In-Home Support Services (IHSS)
- Individual Residential Support Services (IRSS)
- Job Coaching
- Job Development
- Mental Health Transitional Living Homes
- Mentorship
- Pediatric Personal Care
- Personal Care
- Prevocational Services
- Respite
- Specialized Habilitation
- Supported Community Connections
- Supported Living Program

Providers affected by the base wage and/or per diem increase requirements must complete a 2024 Wage Attestation Form and submit it to HCPF to report DCW wages. Attestation forms must be submitted to hcpf_basewage@state.co.us no later than August 30, 2024. Consumer-Directed Attendant Support Services (CDASS) Authorized Representatives and Employers of Record are exempt from attestation requirements. HCBS service providers who do not meet reporting or base wage requirements are subject to audit, corrective action, suspension of claims, and/or recoupment. For non-compliant providers, the suspension of claim payments may be imposed as early as September 9, 2024. Once compliance is achieved, suspended payments will be released. Please note that audits initiated by the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) are a separate process from the submission of the Wage

Attestation Forms and requires the submission of supporting documentation to confirm the information submitted on the Wage Attestation Forms by providers.

Action To Be Taken:

Providers must increase impacted DCW wages to at least the new \$17.00/hour (\$18.29/hour in Denver) base wage by July 1, 2024. Providers must also increase per diem wages for impacted DCWs by the percent of HCPF's July 1, 2024, rate increase. Providers must keep detailed records that support their actions related to increasing DCW wages.
