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Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this memo is to advise eligibility sites of the Medicare Savings Program (MSP) and Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) 2025 income limits. MSP Categories include: Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries (QMB), Specified Low-income Medicare Beneficiaries (SLMB), Qualified Individuals (QI-1), and Qualified Disabled Working Individuals (QDWI). Please share this memo with anyone who works with these programs.

Information:

The income limits for the QMB, SLMB, QI-1, QDWI and LIS programs are based on federal poverty level (FPL) guidelines that are updated annually. The 2025 guidelines were published on January 17, 2025 (Federal Register, Vol 90, No. 11, pages 5917-5918).

The MSP income limits listed below include the \$20 unearned income disregard. The QDWI program does not include the earned income disregard, as this is already programmed in CBMS when earned income is entered.

Effective April 1, 2025, the Colorado Benefits Management System (CBMS) will be updated to reflect the new income guidelines for Medicare Savings Programs. Eligibility Sites must refer to these updated income guidelines as of April 1st when making an eligibility determination.
