5. Regional Accountable Entity Policy Guidance on Enhancing Care Coordination for Members admitted to a Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility or a Qualified Residential Treatment Program

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of this guidance is to identify the expectations of Regional Accountable Entity (RAE) Care Coordination engagement and participation with and for pediatric Members admitted to residential behavioral



health treatment facilities. These expectations will ensure appropriate and timely care is supported by the Member's care team and enhance access to the full spectrum of Medicaid-covered behavioral health treatment services for Members with high-acuity behavioral health needs during and following residential treatment (e.g., Colorado System of Care identification & referrals). Care Coordinator and RAE Subcontracted Care Coordinator are synonymous for the purposes of this guidance.
