

## **HEALTH FIRST COLORADO BUY-IN PROGRAM**

for Children with Disabilities

Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) Buy-In offers health care coverage for children with disabilities whose family earnings and resources might otherwise make them ineligible for Health First Colorado.

### **Who Qualifies**



People who meet disability criteria



Children ages 0 - 18



People who may have private insurance that excludes or limits essential services



Family incomes not exceeding 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (disregards may apply)



Children with complex needs not covered through most private insurance plans

### How It Works<sup>1</sup>



Families pay a monthly premium according to the chart below.

Before Buy-In, families often had to restrict how much the parents worked so their child could qualify for essential services through Health First Colorado. Buy-In can make the difference between a family's financial survival, bankruptcy or debt.

Includes all regular Health First Colorado benefits



No co-pays

### How It's Funded



Funded by the Hospital Provider Fee.



No State General fund is used.
