**Basic Homemaker**

**Definition**

Services that consist of the performance of basic household tasks within the participants primary residence. This assistance may take the form of hands-on assistance (actually performing a task for the participant) or cuing to prompt the participant to perform a task.

1. Cleaning, laundry, or household care (IADLs)
2. Maintenance (IADLs)

**Enhanced Homemaker:**

**Definition**

Services provided that consist of the same household tasks as described under Basic Homemaker services with the addition of either habilitation or extraordinary cleaning.

**Covered Services**

1. Habilitation includes direct training and instruction to the participant. (IADLs; Independent living Skills Training)
2. Extraordinary cleaning as a result of the participant's behavioral or medical needs (IADLs).

*Residential Services are not to be delivered simultaneously during the direct provision of, or be on the same Person-Centered Service Plan as, the following waiver services: Assistive Technology (Personal Support Technology); Caregiver Supports; Chore Services; Personal Supports; Intensive Supports (Short Term; Site-Based); or Transition Services (Life Skills Training).*

Residential Habilitation Services and Supports are designed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the participant, and to assist in the acquisition, retention and/or improvement in skills necessary to support the participant to live and participate successfully in their community.
