### **The Goal of Waiver Redesign:**

The goal of the Adult IDD Waiver Redesign is to consolidate the Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Developmental Disabilities (DD) and Supported Living Services (SLS) waivers into a single HCBS waiver for Adults with IDD. This new waiver will include an array of broad, flexible services and spectrum of service delivery options that enhance individual choice, autonomy and community engagement. This waiver will also employ Person-Centered Planning and service delivery that provides for health and safety assurances and sound stewardship of public funds.
